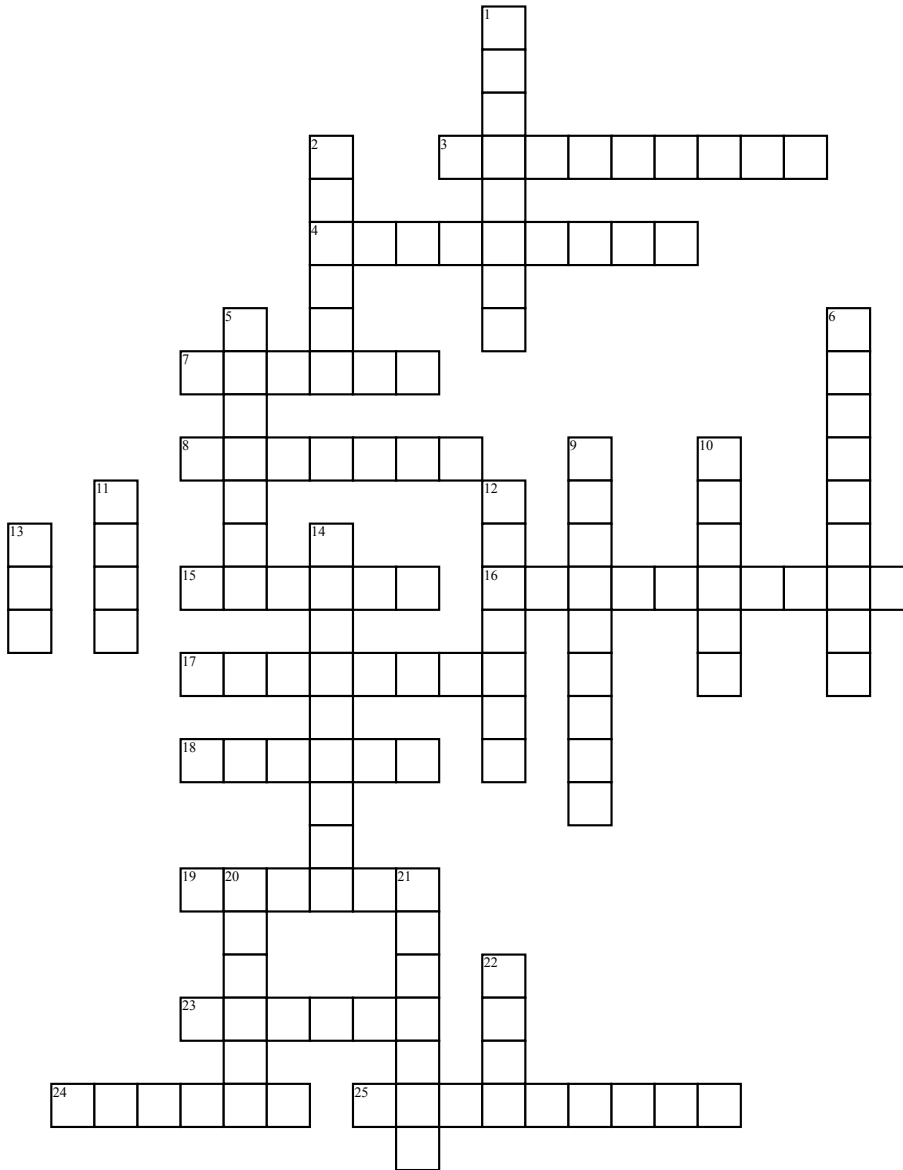


WOD Crossword Puzzles
