

- 7. PLACED IN BED FOR A BRADEN SCORE LESS THAN 18

- 11. THE DESTRUCTION OF TISSUE OR ULCERATION EXTENDING UNDER THE SKIN EDGES SO THAT THE PRESSURE ULCER IS LARGER AT ITS BASE THAN AT THE SKIN SURFACE
- **12.** WHAT WE PLACE OUTSIDE OF A DOOR TO KNOW A PATIENT HAS A BRADEN SCORE OF 18 OR LESS
- 13. THE AMOUNT OF HAPIS ACQUIRED THIS YEAR ON 3400 UNIT 15. OF OR PERTAINING TO THE DEATH OF TISSUE IN RESPONSE TO DISEASE OR INJURY

1. A THICK LAYER OF DEAD, DRY TISSUE THAT COVERS A PRESSURE ULCER OR THERMAL BURN

- 6. SKIN INSPECTION COMPLETED AT BEDSIDE WITH BRADEN SCORE LESS THAN 18- TO BE DONE UPON ADMISSION, DAILY, UPON TRANSFERS TO/FROM SNF, OR OTHER UNITS
- **8.** A RESULT OF SHEARING, FRICTION OR TRAUMA TO THE SKIN
