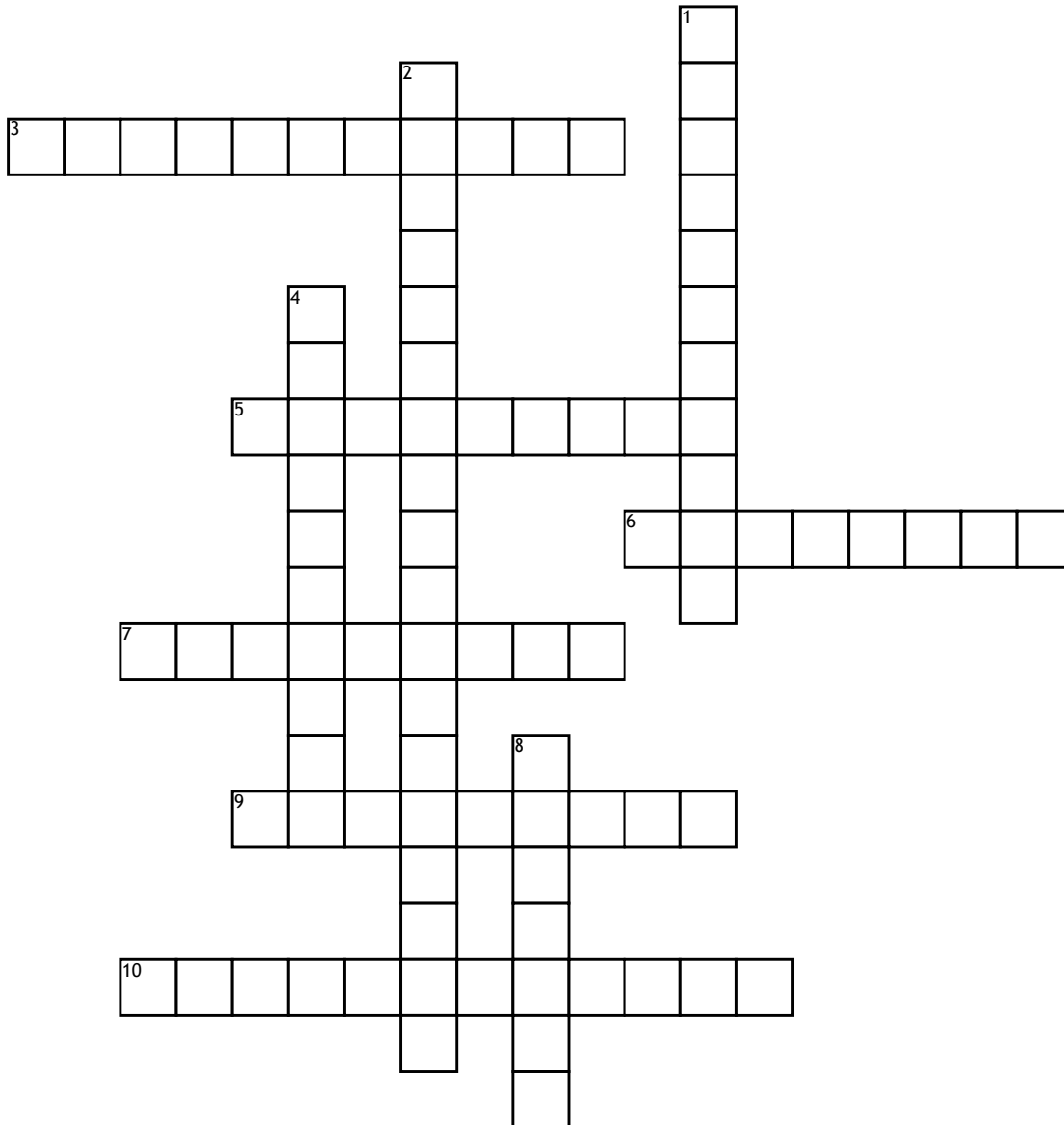

- 3. a place where stocks and bonds are "traded" - meaning bought and sold. The goal is to buy the stock, hold it for a time, and then sell the stock for more than you paid for it; investing.
- 5. The killing of millions of Jews and other people by the Nazis during World War II
- 6. the planned killing of a race of people
- 7. people of Northern European descent who were believed by the Nazis to be the "pure race"
- 9. the National Socialist German Workers' Party. Under Adolf Hitler's leadership, the Nazis started World War II.
- 10. Hostility to or prejudice against Jews

- 1. Leader of the National Socialist (Nazi) Party (from 1920/21) and chancellor and Führer of Germany (1933-45)
- 2. was the most important of the peace treaties that brought World War I to an end. The Treaty ended the state of war between Germany and the Allied Powers (Germany was blamed)
- 4. Information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote or publicize a particular political cause or point of view.
- 8. a political movement that puts the needs of a nation above individual needs and has an autocratic leader, severe economic and social regimentation, and forcible suppression of opposition.
