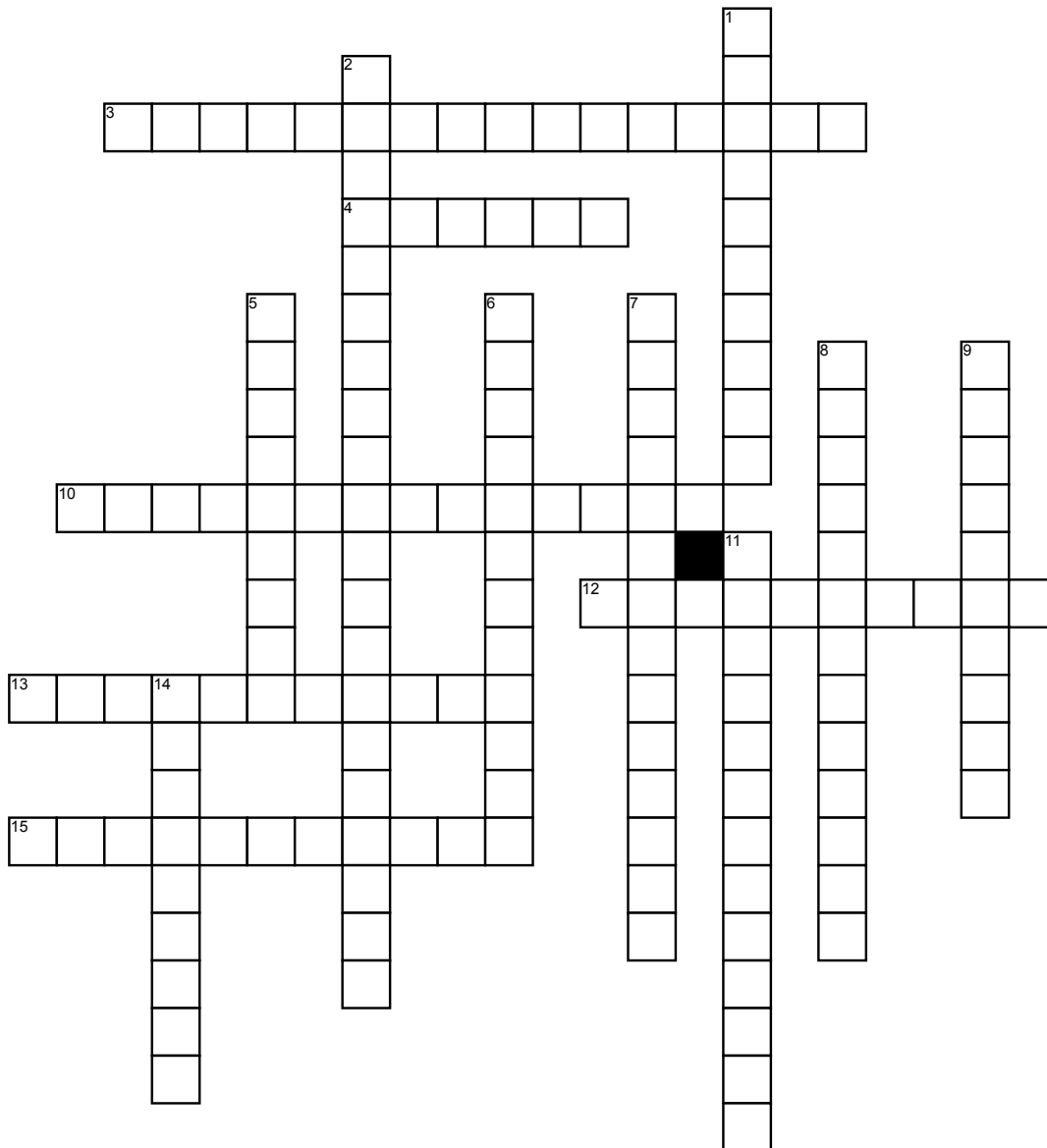


WW1 Crossword
