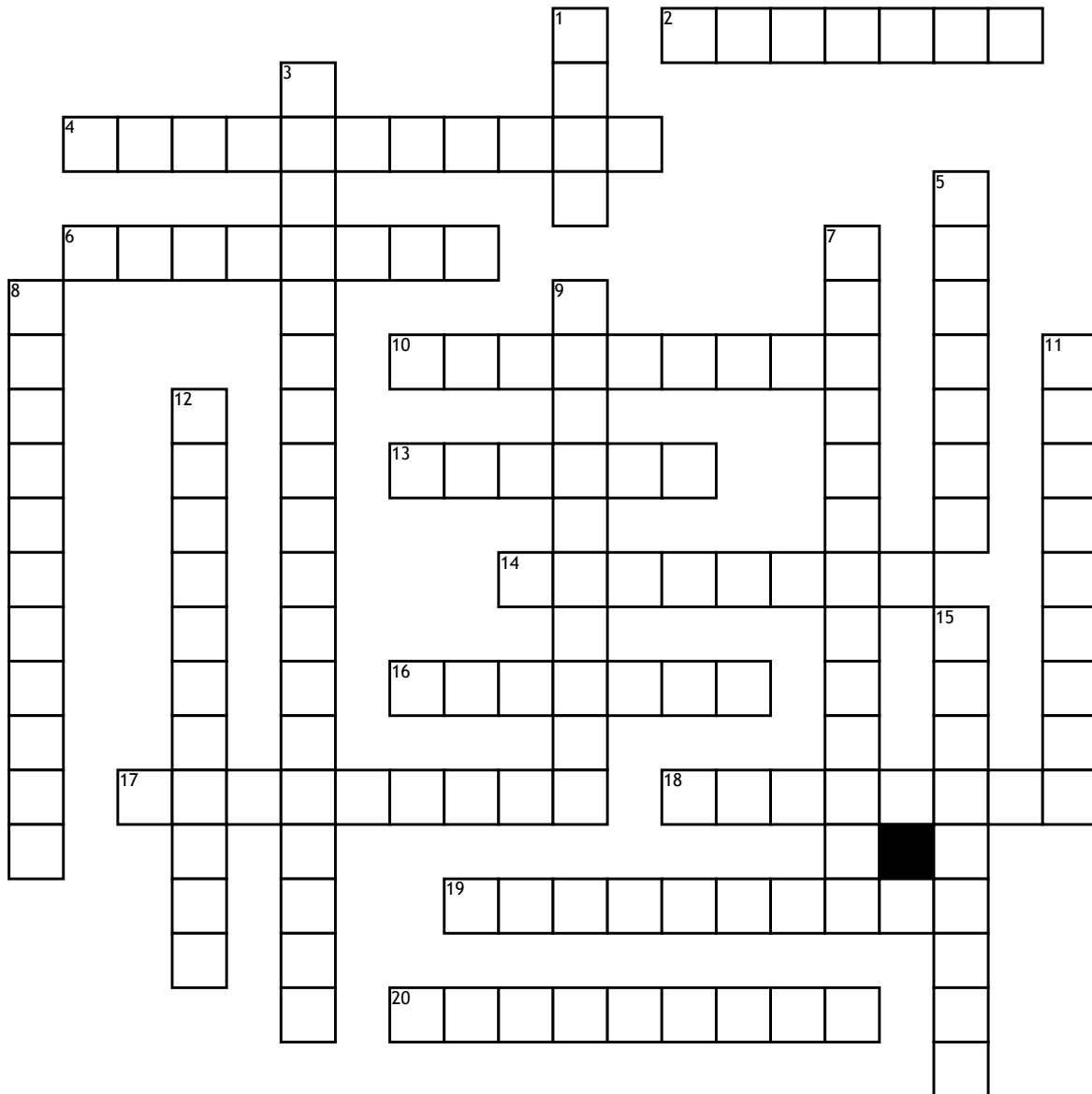


# WW1 crossword puzzle
