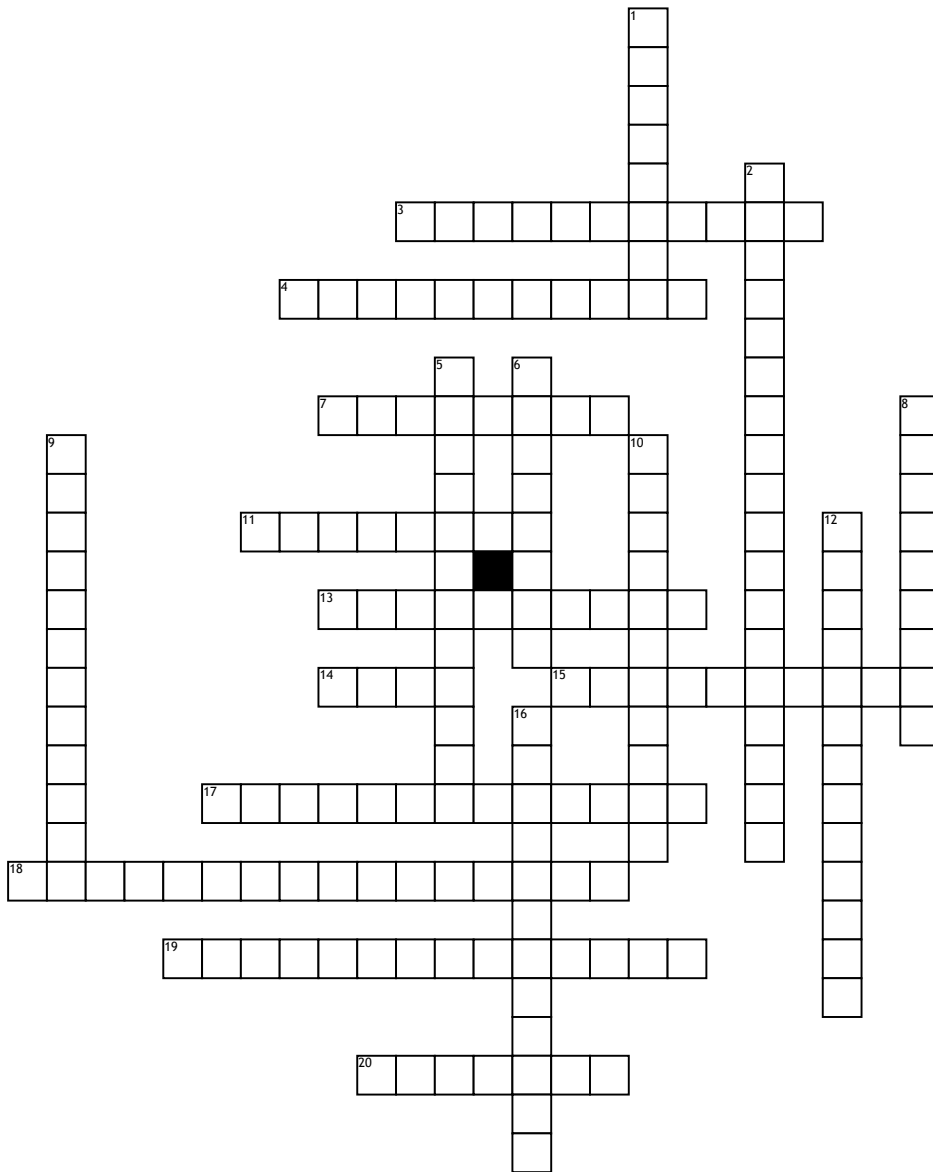


WWII Crossword Puzzle
