

# WWI & Robert Borden --- Definition



## Across

- 2. the right of a detained person to be brought before a judge or the official to decide whether the detention is lawful
- 6. an act that allowed men and women serving overseas to vote
- 8. an act that gave the vote to Canadian women related to servicemen, but cancelled the vote for conscientious objectors and immigrants from enemy countries
- 9. an Act that gives the federal government emergency powers during wartime, including the right to detain people without laying charges
- 10. a government-run camp where people who are considered a threat are detained.

- 11. a person who opposes war for religious/moral reasons

- 1. a 1917 Act that made conscription compulsory for all Canadian men between the ages 20 and 45, calling up the younger men first
- 3. the coalition government formed by conservatives and some liberals and independents that governed Canada from 1917-1920
- 4. the name given to the 1917 federal election because of Borden's efforts to win the military vote
- 5. Forced enlistment in armed forces of all fit men of certain ages
- 7. groups organized to improve conditions for workers
