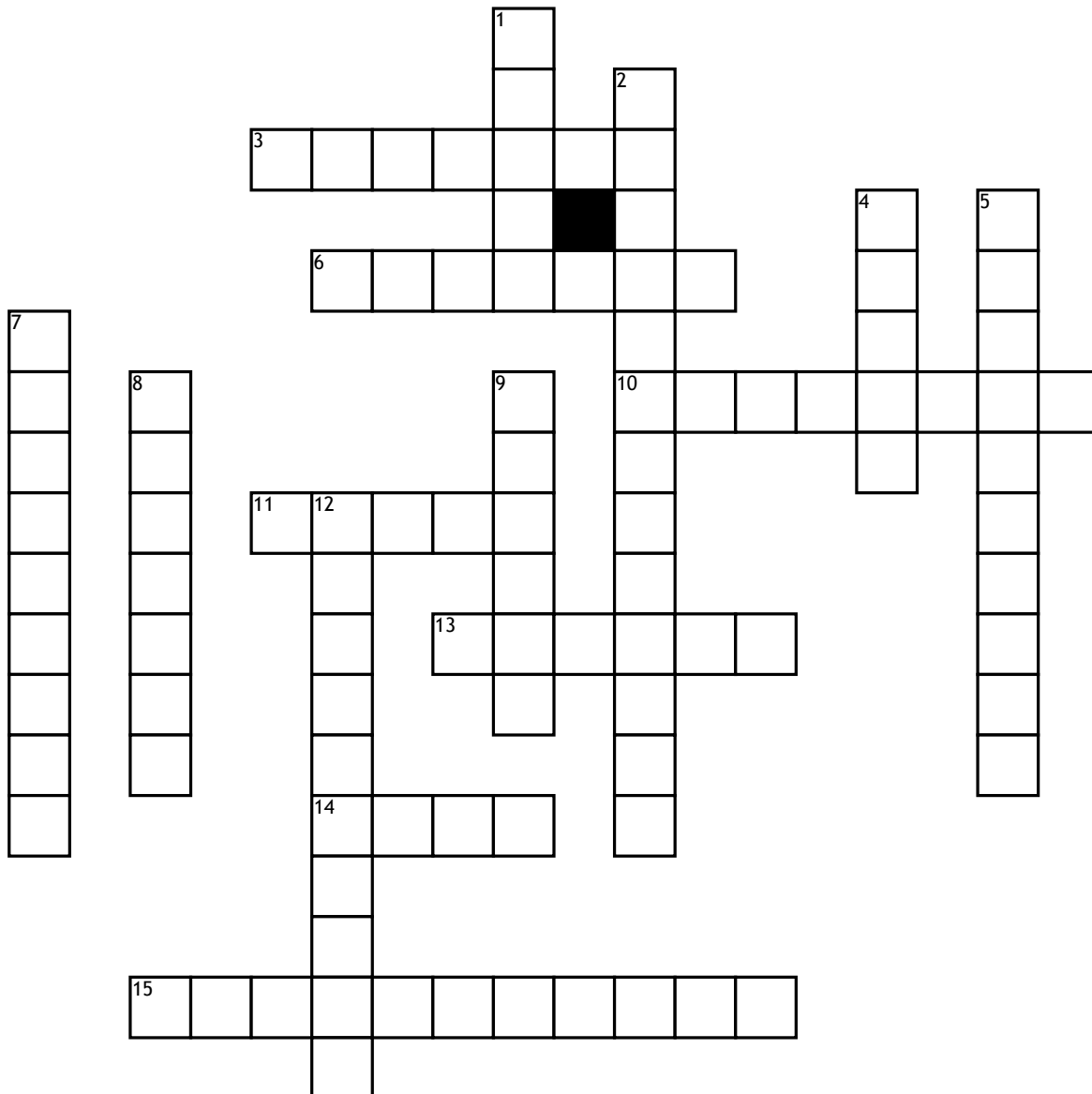


Warfare ancient Egypt
