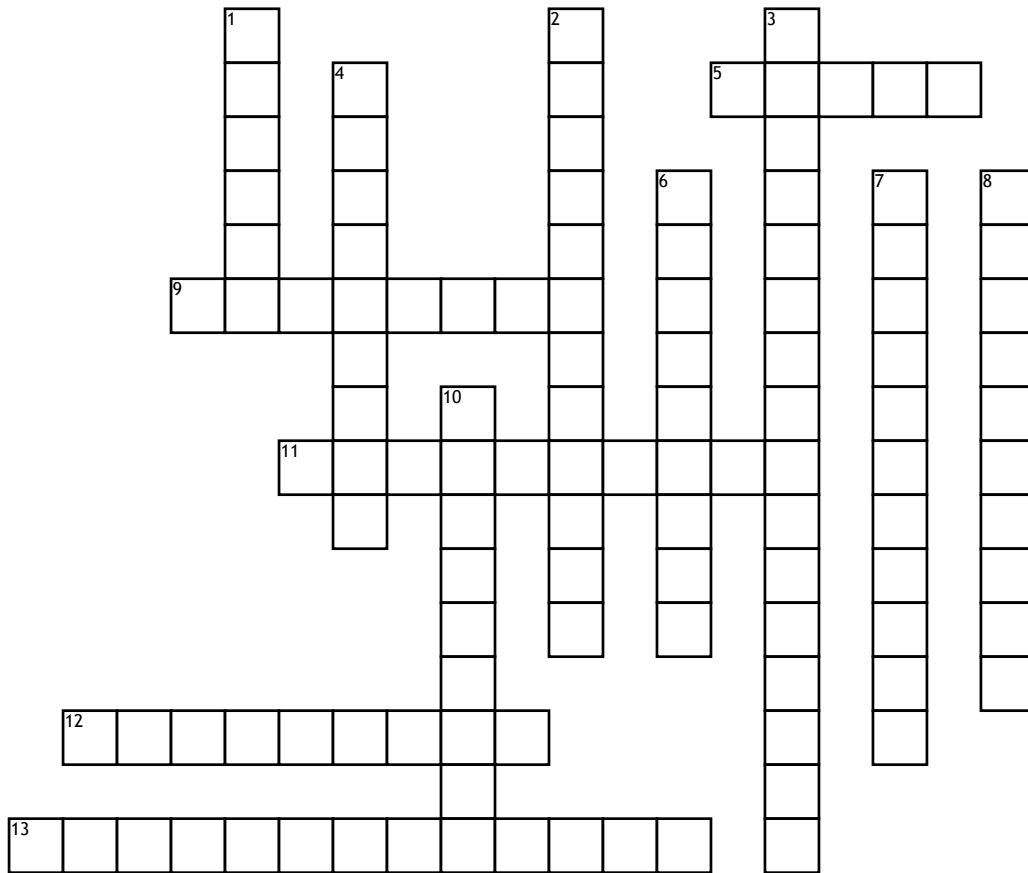


Waste Management

5. any unwanted material or substance that results from human activity or process
 9. the liquid that results when substances from the trash dissolve in water as rainwater percolates downward
 11. Waste that comes from the production of consumer goods, mining, agriculture, and petroleum extraction and refining
 12. Type of waste that is toxic, chemically reactive, flammable, or corrosive
 13. materials that decompose or break down naturally

Down

1. electronic waste, such as old computers and cell phones
 2. a controlled process in which mixed garbage is burned at very high temperatures
 3. A place in which waste is buried in the ground or piled up in large mounds
 4. the collection of materials that can be broken down and reprocessed to make new items
 6. Non-liquid waste that comes from homes, institutions, and small businesses
 7. waste that gives off radiation and is harmful to humans and the environment

8. the conversion of organic waste into mulch or humus through biological processes of decomposition
 10. a cleanup program developed to address U.S. sites polluted with hazardous waste from past activities
