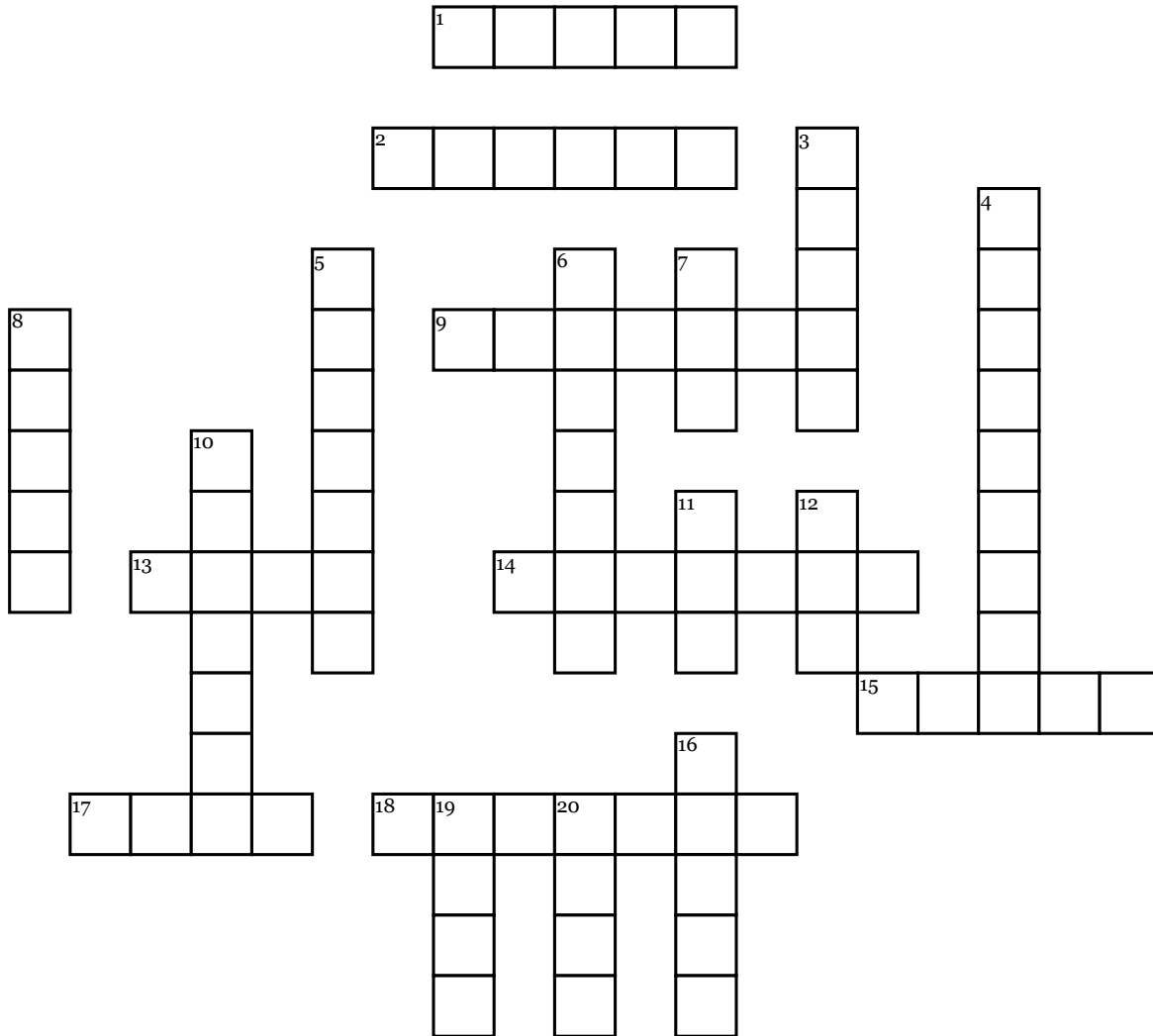

- 2.** A visible mass of condensed watery vapour floating in the atmosphere
- 9.** A place on the coast where ships may moor in shelter
- 13.** A large area of water surrounded by land
- 14.** A slowly moving mass or river of ice
- 15.** A curve or recess in a coastline, river, or other geographical feature

- 17.** A deep inlet of the sea almost surrounded by land
- 18.** A large floating mass of ice

- 4.** A branch of a river forming a backwater or stagnant pool
