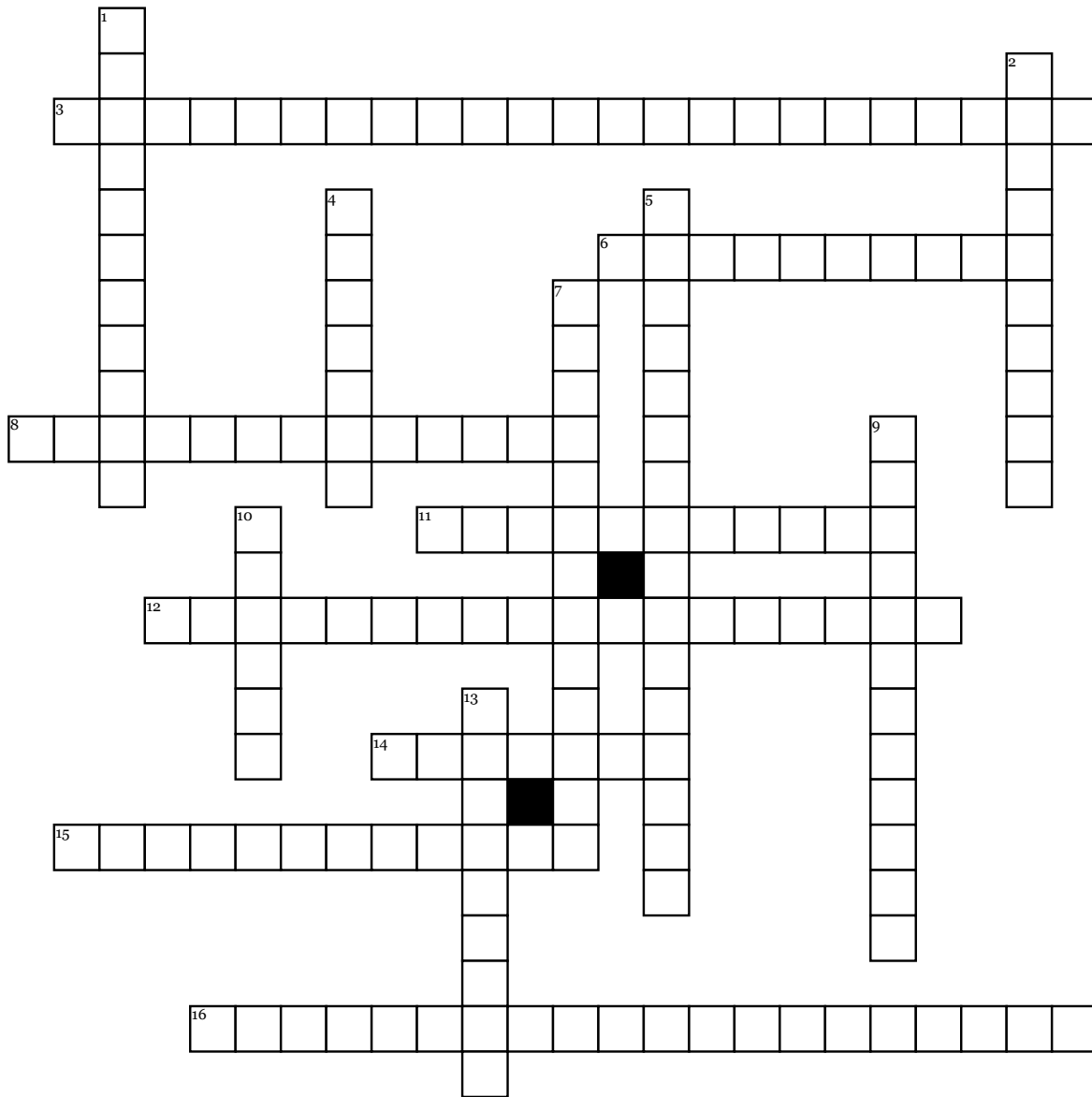


# Water cycle crossword puzzle
