

- 4.** the degree of purity of water, determined by measuring the substances in water, besides water molecules

- 5.** the process of using a resource wisely so it will not be used up
- 6.** a specific source of pollution that can be identified, such as a pipe
- 7.** the process of reclaiming and reusing raw materials
- 8.** the land area that supplies water to a river system
