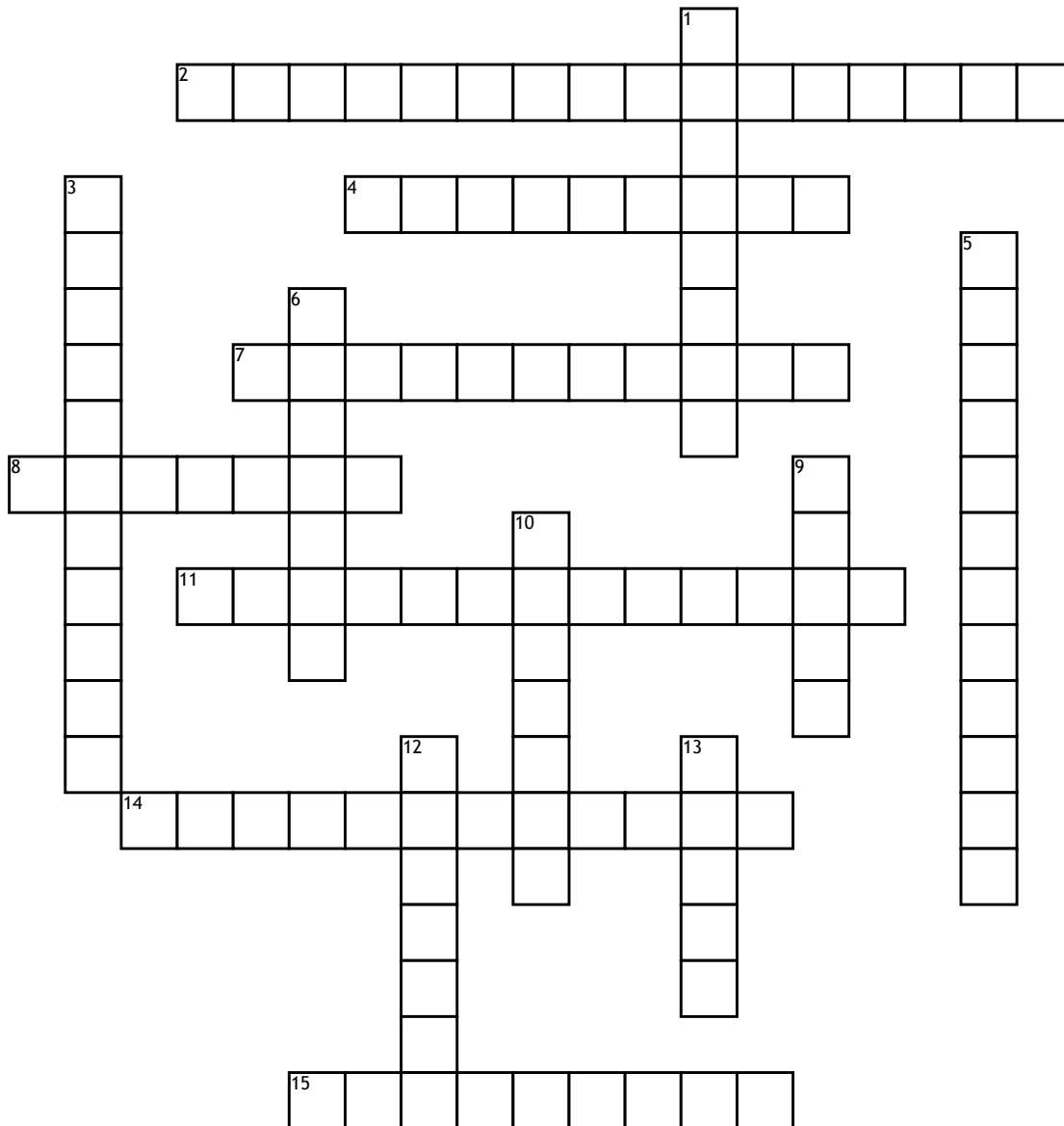


# Weather Crossword
