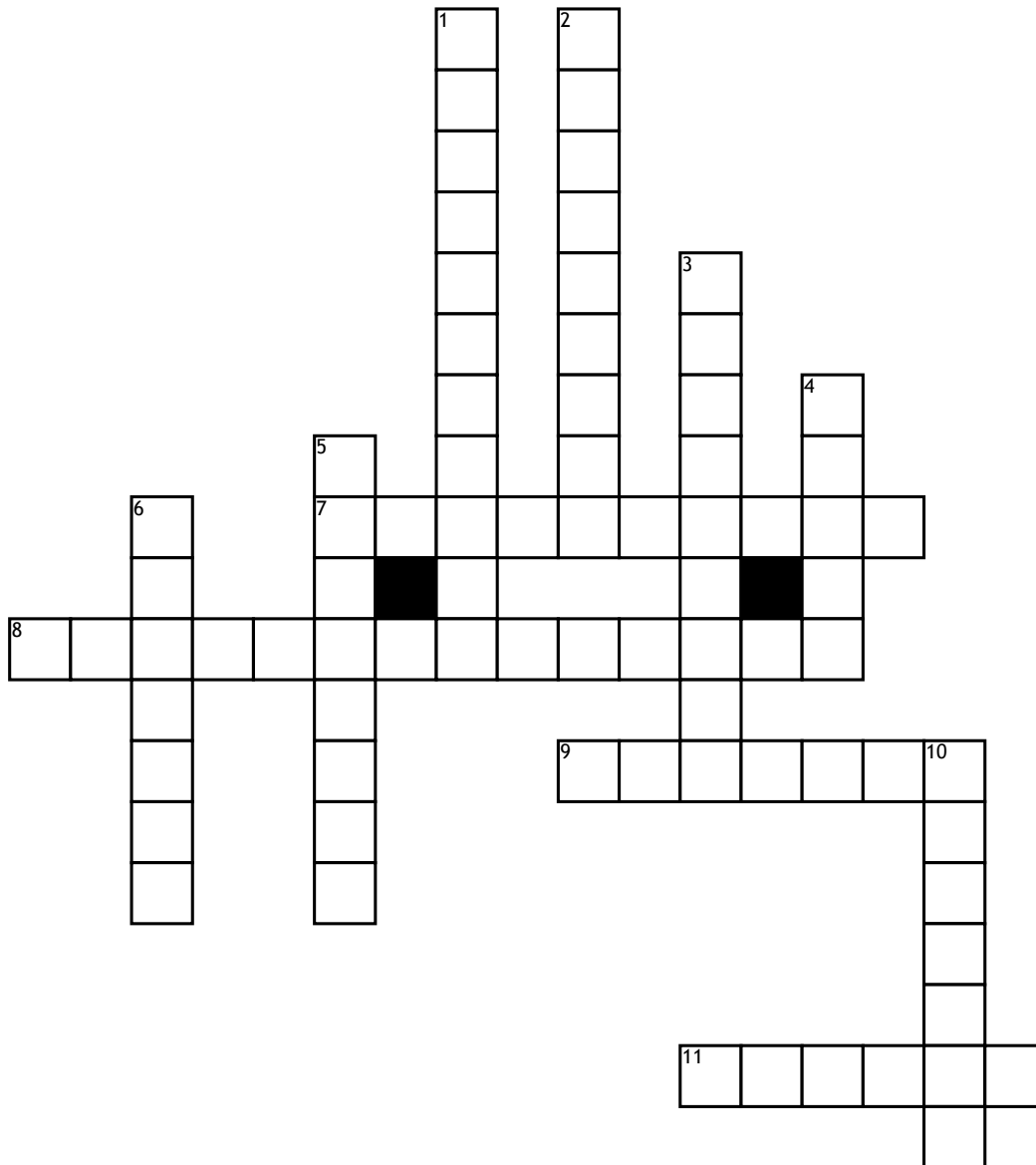

7. Transfer of heat in a liquid or a gas
 8. Causes moving air and water to turn left in the southern hemisphere and turn right in the northern hemisphere due to Earth's rotation
 9. Fluffy, white clouds, usually with flat bottoms, that look like rounded piles of cotton
 11. Wispy, feathery clouds made mostly of ice crystals that form at high levels

1. Winds that blow steadily from specific directions over long distances

2. Huge, rotating storms that form over the ocean near the equator
 3. Narrow belt of strong winds that blow near the top of the troposphere
 4. Boundary between two air masses; can be cold, warm, occluded, and stationary
 5. Front where warm air mass is caught between two cooler air masses
 6. A rapidly whirling, funnel-shaped cloud that reaches down from a storm cloud to touch Earth's surface
 10. Clouds that form in flat layers and often cover much of the sky
