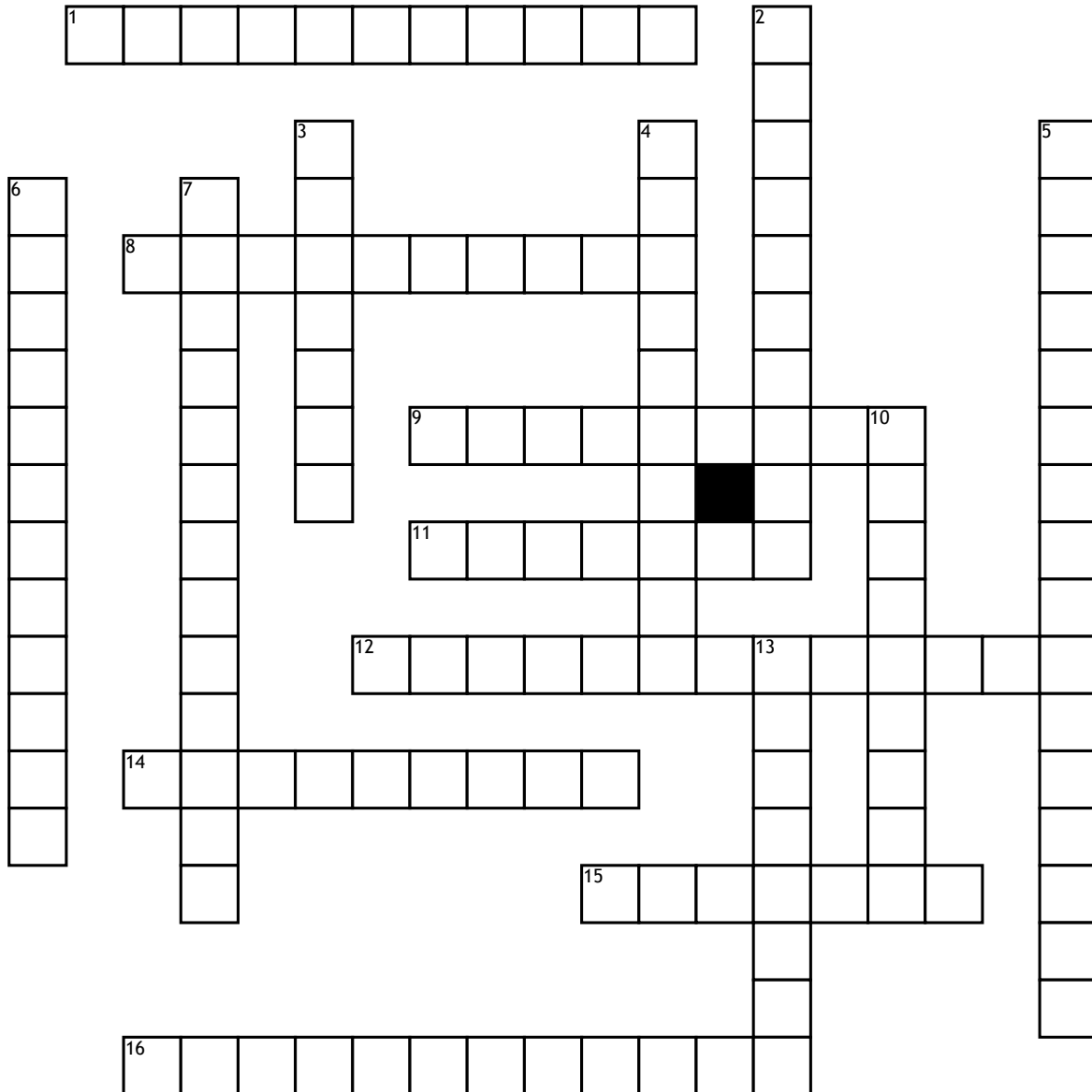

- 15. The condition of earth 's atmosphere at a particular time and place
 - 16. A climate zone near the equator characterized by warm temperatures due to direct sunlight year-round

- 2. Measures the amount of water vapor or humidity
 - 3. The average weather conditions in an area over a long period of time; seasonal pattern of weather conditions in an area over many years; does not change rapidly

- 4. Measures the wind speed
- 5. Photographs and tracks large scale movements
- 6. Determined mainly by the location, or latitude, of the zone
- 7. Characterized by a seasonal climate, wide range of temperatures, hot and cold
- 10. Measures the amount of rainfall
