

## **Across**

- **2.** Mass Movement that doesn't move very fast. Made of blocks of materials moving on a curved surface.
- **5.** A type of mass movement that slides, consisting of pieces of bedrock.
- **10.** Breaking rocks up, but not changing its mineral composition using only physical forces.
- **11.** The moving of soil/debris down a slope.

- **12.** The vertical part of soil that goes through all of the horizons.
- **13.** Water getting into cracks of rocks, freezes and expands, and thaws. Rocks break into pieces.

## **Down**

- 1. A quick mass movement flow made up of soil, rock, and water.
- **3.** Transformation of rock into new compounds.

- **4.** Layer of mineral pieces and rock casued by weathering.
- **6.** Outer rock slabs that break off in layers.
- **7.** Growth supporting part of regolith.
- **8.** Large piles created by sections of rocks that were wedged loose.
- **9.** The slowest mass movement; usually caused by freezing and thawing.
