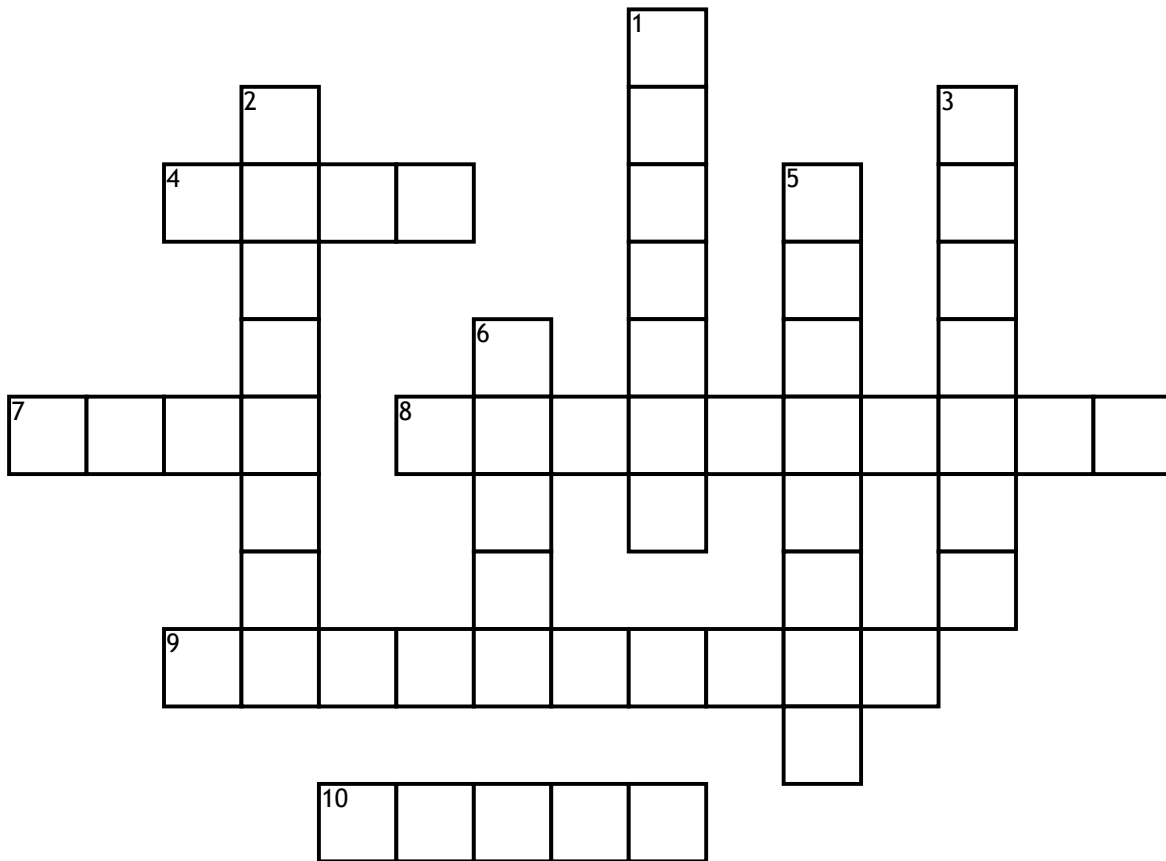


Weathering and Erosion

- 4. tunnel type area where rock has been dissolved by moving water
- 7. moving air
- 8. the process by which weathered and eroded material is deposited or dropped by wind, water or ice
- 9. breaking rocks into smaller pieces, or the action of physical conditions on the earth causing earth materials (rocks) to change in color, texture, composition, or form
- 10. sediment deposited at the mouth of a river that causes land to extend out into the water over time

Down

- 1. process of breaking down earth materials and moving them from one place to another
- 2. sediment that has been deposited in piles by wind
- 3. large mass of ice that has collected over many years and gradually moves down mountains eroding underlying rock as it goes
- 5. broken pieces of rock
- 6. sandy area where a body of water meets the land, rocks have been broken into small pieces by moving water
