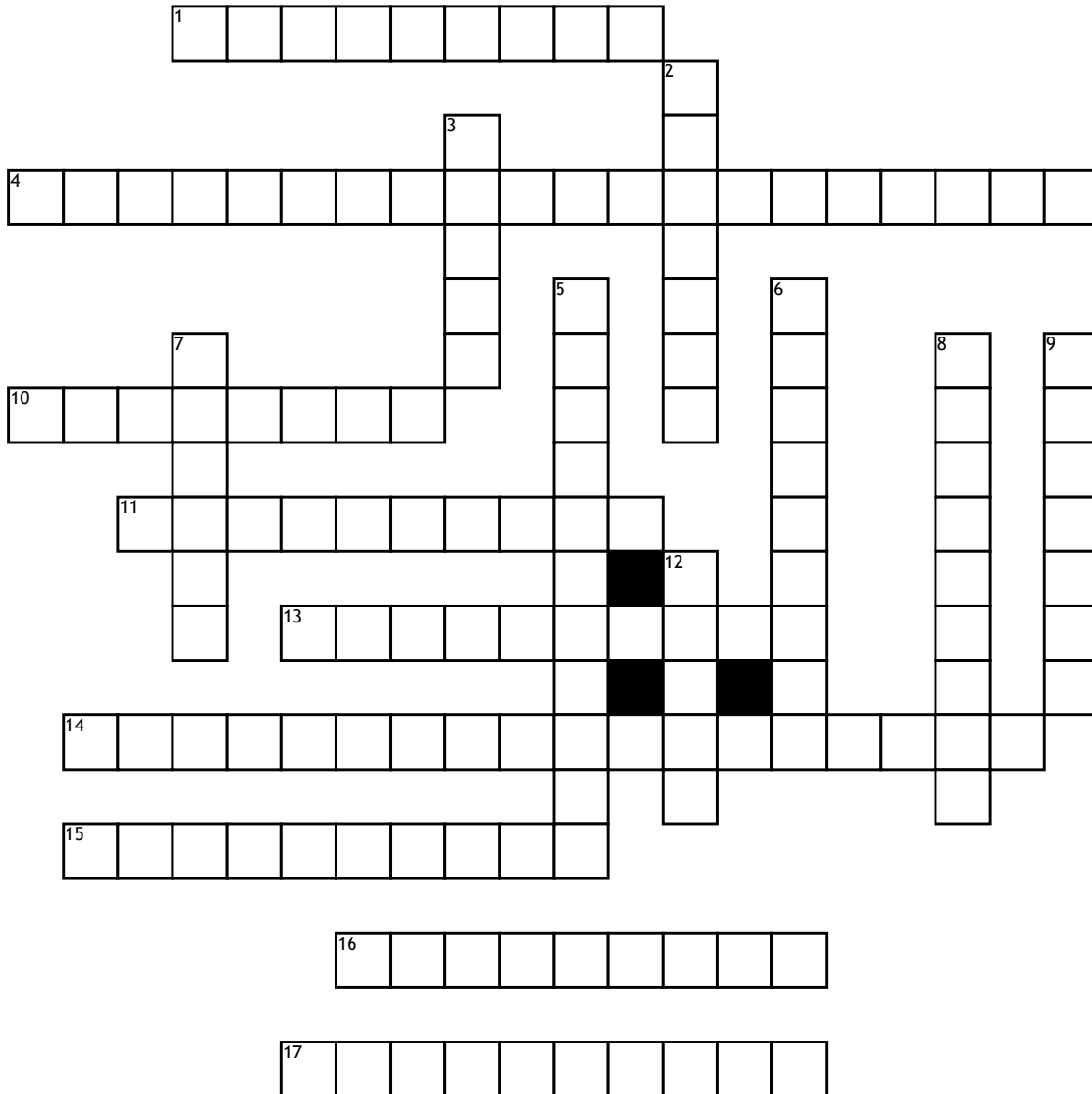


Weathering and Erosion
