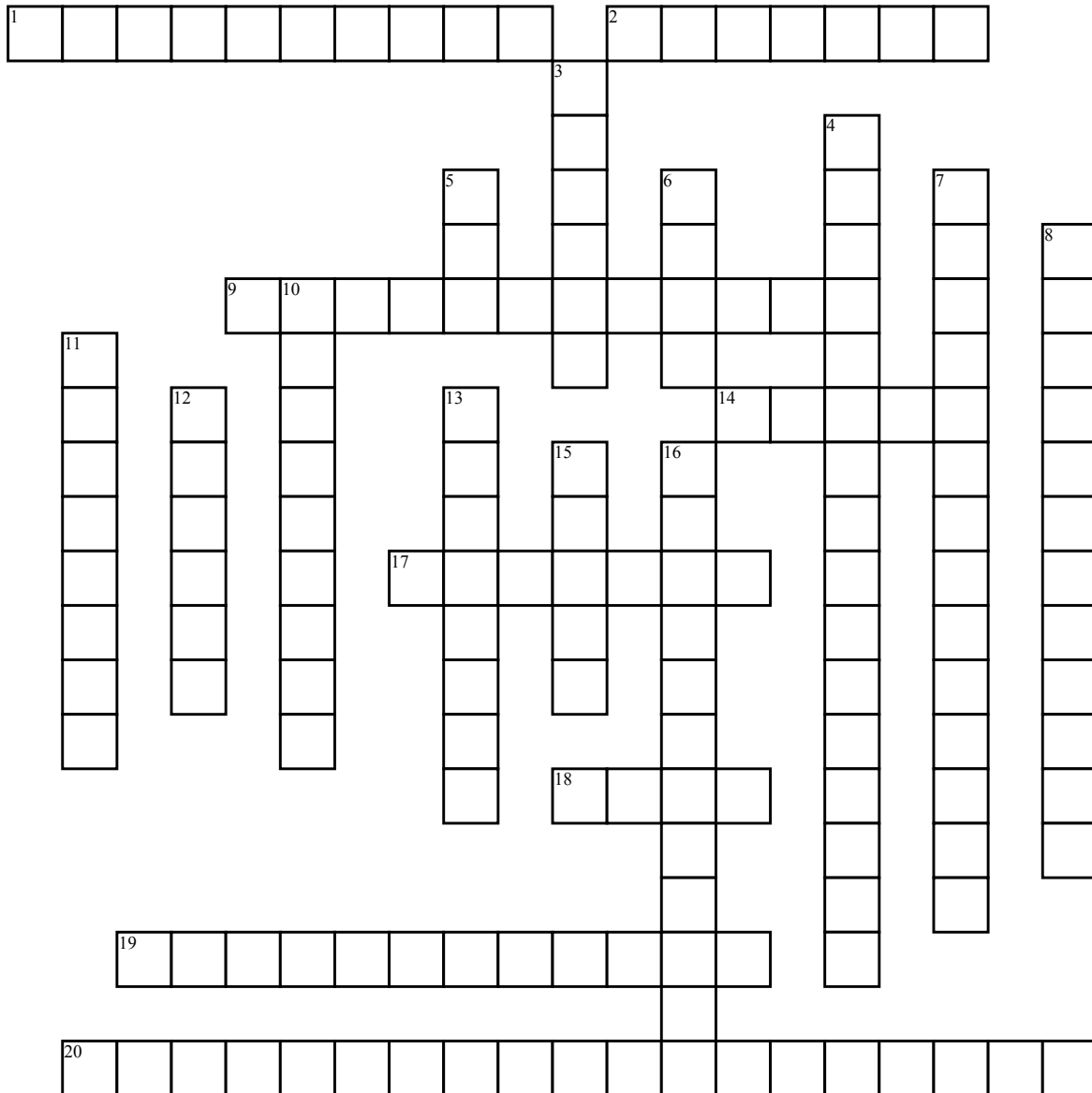


Week 1 Crossword Puzzle
