

- **4.** The lack of this response may indicate neurological disorder
- **8.** Breaking amnion to hopefully prompt the body to go into labor on its own
- **9.** An alternative to vaginal birth
- **10.** The baby is essentially in any position except head down
- **12.** Born at least 3 weeks or more before the due date
- 13. Oxygen deficiency at birth

- **14.** A surgical cut made on the opening of the vagina to avoid tearing and to aid in the birth process
- **15.** The umbilical cord comes out before the baby and this could cause the baby to put pressure on the cord and disrupt blood flow to the baby

1. The mother's pelvis is not large enough for baby to pass though

- 2. When the placenta detaches from the wall of the uterus before delivery, causing disruption of blood flow and nutrients to baby and heavy bleeding for mother
