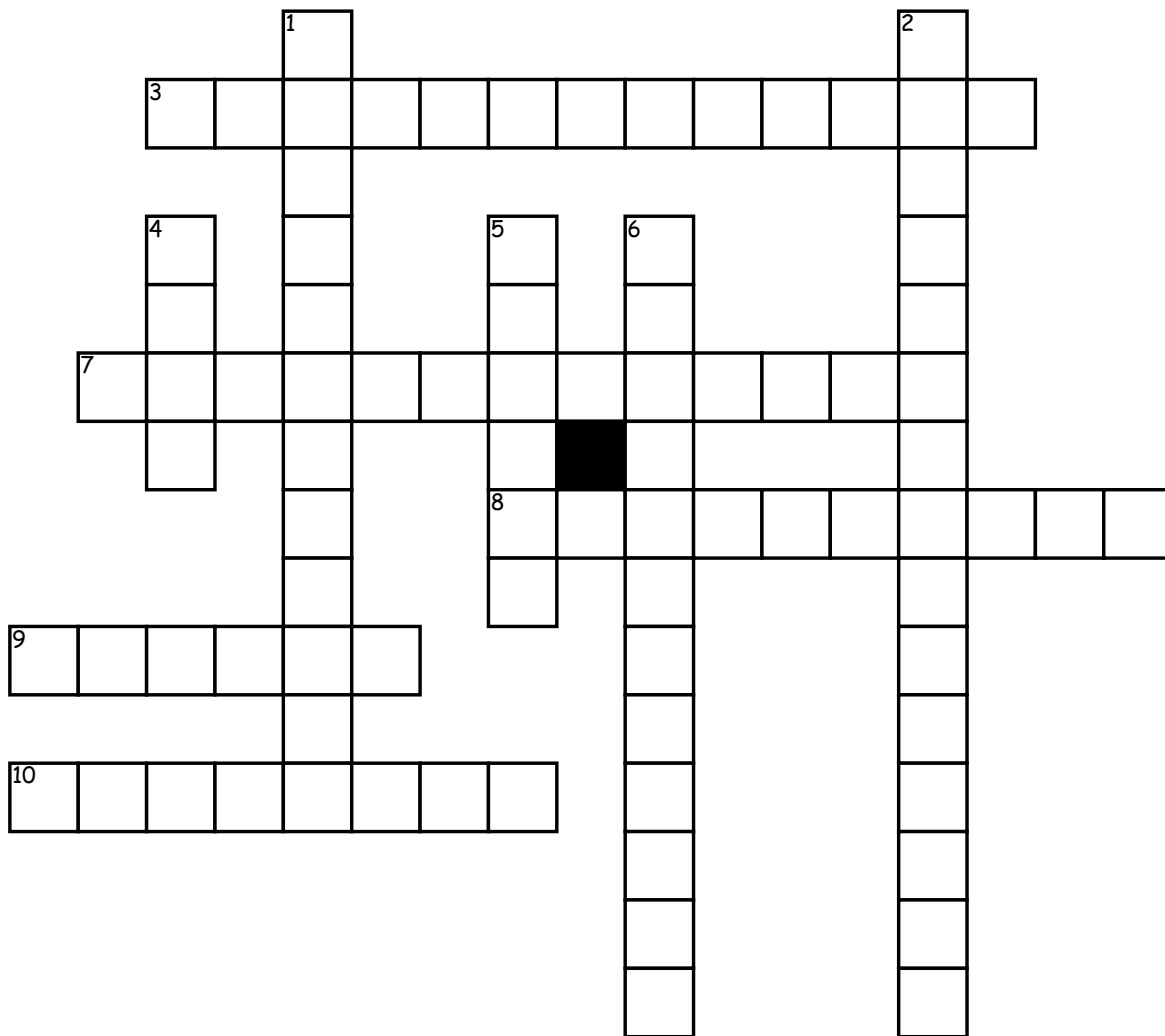

3. natural opening in the root
7. the portion of the tooth that is visible in the oral cavity
8. without teeth
9. hard portion of the root that surround the pulp and is covered by enamel on the crown and by cementum on the root
10. specialized, calcified connective tissue that covers the anatomic root of the tooth

## Down

1. mixture of permanent and primary teeth that occurs until all the primary teeth are lost usually during the ages of 6-12 years old.
2. microscopic canals found in dentin
4. part in the center of a tooth made up of living connective tissue and cells called odontoblasts
5. this, leaf like structure that extends from the enamel surface toward the dentinoenamel junction and consists of organic material with little mineral content
6. permanent teeth
