

1. Development of strong affectional ties between an infant and a significant other (e.g. mother, father, sibling, caretaker)
2. Transient emotional disturbances
3. Encompasses the time after delivery as the woman's body begins to return to the pre-pregnant state
5. Development of a close emotional attachment to a newborn by the parents during the first 30 to 60 minutes after birth
6. This state of the uterus allows for excessive bleeding
7. Sensory experiences such as touching, holding, and gazing at the newborn
