

- 4. The vaginal discharge that occurs after the birth of the placenta
- 8. Involves three retrogressive processes, which include contraction of muscle fibers, catabolism, and regeneration 2. Transient emotional disturbances of uterine epithelium
- 9. Physical and psychological experience of the parents being close to their infant
- 10. The father's developing a bond with his newborn, which is a time of intenseabsorption, pre-occupation, and interestn

- 1. Development of strong affectional ties between an infant and a significant other (e.g. mother, father, sibling, caretaker)
- 3. Encompasses the time after delivery as the woman's body begins to return to the pre-pregnant state
- 5. Development of a close emotional attachment to a newborn by the parents during the first 30 to 60 minutes after birth
- 6. This state of the uterus allows for excessive bleeding
- 7. Senory experiences such as touching, holding, and gazing at the newborn
