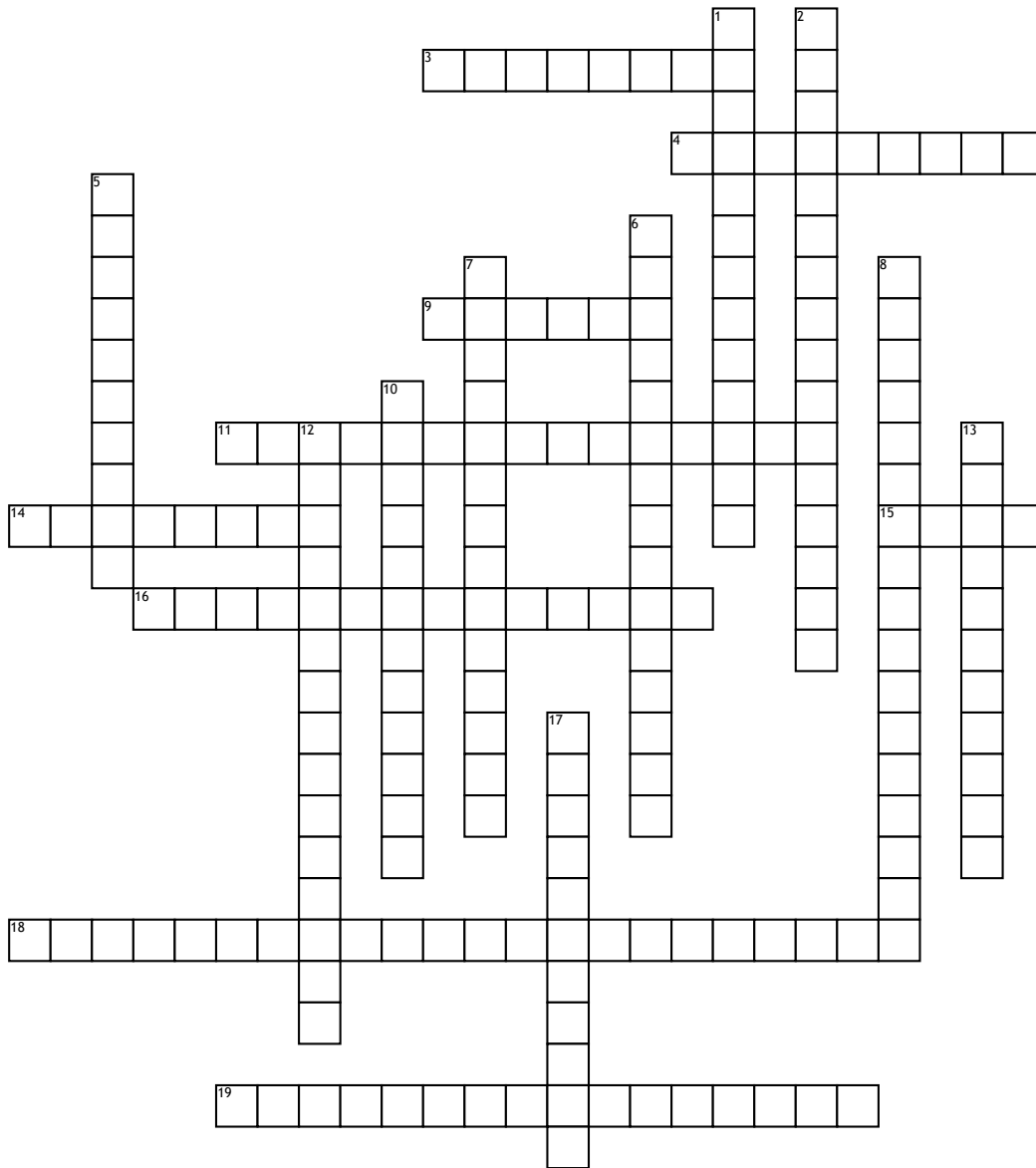


Weekly Crossword
