
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Westward Expansion Territories

- 3. "From sea to shining sea."
- **6.** Began in 1848 and brought 300,000 Americans from the east to the west after news of gold spread
- 9. The country north of the US
- **10.** Country in Europe; sold America the Louisiana Purchase
- 12. Split Oregon at 49 degrees latitude; North share of land was for British while South share was for the US
- **13.** After conquering Mexico's capital, the US forced Mexico to sell this territory

- 15. This Native American woman helped Lewis and Clark on the expedition in the Louisiana Purchase
- **16.** Country south of America
- 17. Sold the Louisiana Purchase fro France to the US
- **18.** This future president led the US army to conquere the Spanish colony of Florida
- 19. The US purchased this territory from Mexico after realizing they couldn't build a continenetal Railroad across the Rockies
- **20.** The Native Americans that harbored runaway slaves in Florida
