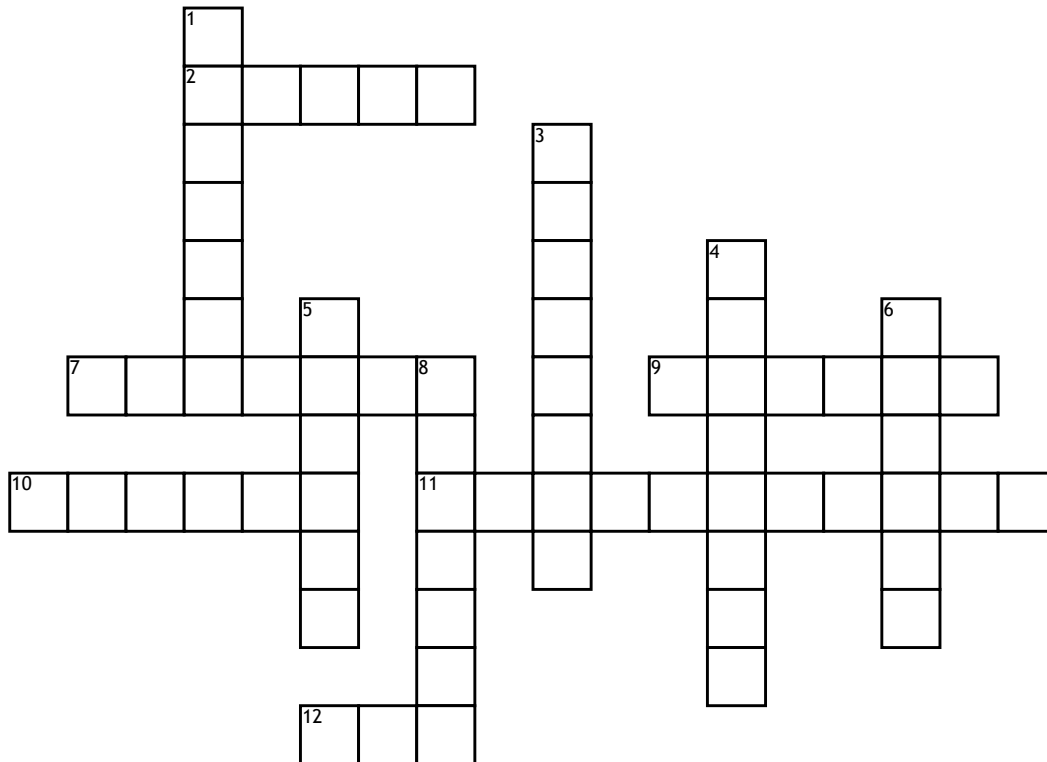


Where UK skiers go to ski
