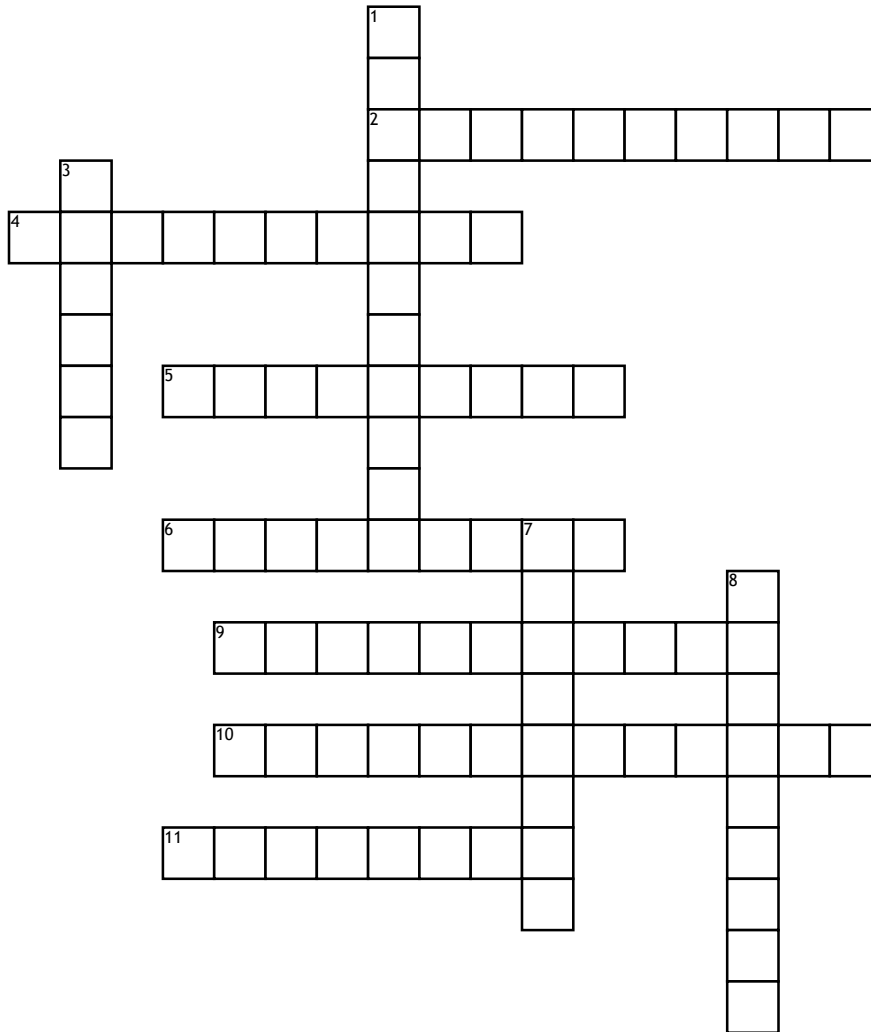


# Williams fancy shmancy crossword

1. adjective /ə'prɒprēət/ suitable or proper in the circumstances.  
 3. verb past tense: echoed; past participle: echoed 1. (of a sound) be repeated or reverberate after the original sound has stopped. "their footsteps echoed on the metal catwalks"  
 7. adverb completely (often used for emphasis).  
 8. adjective: not certain or fixed; provisional.
