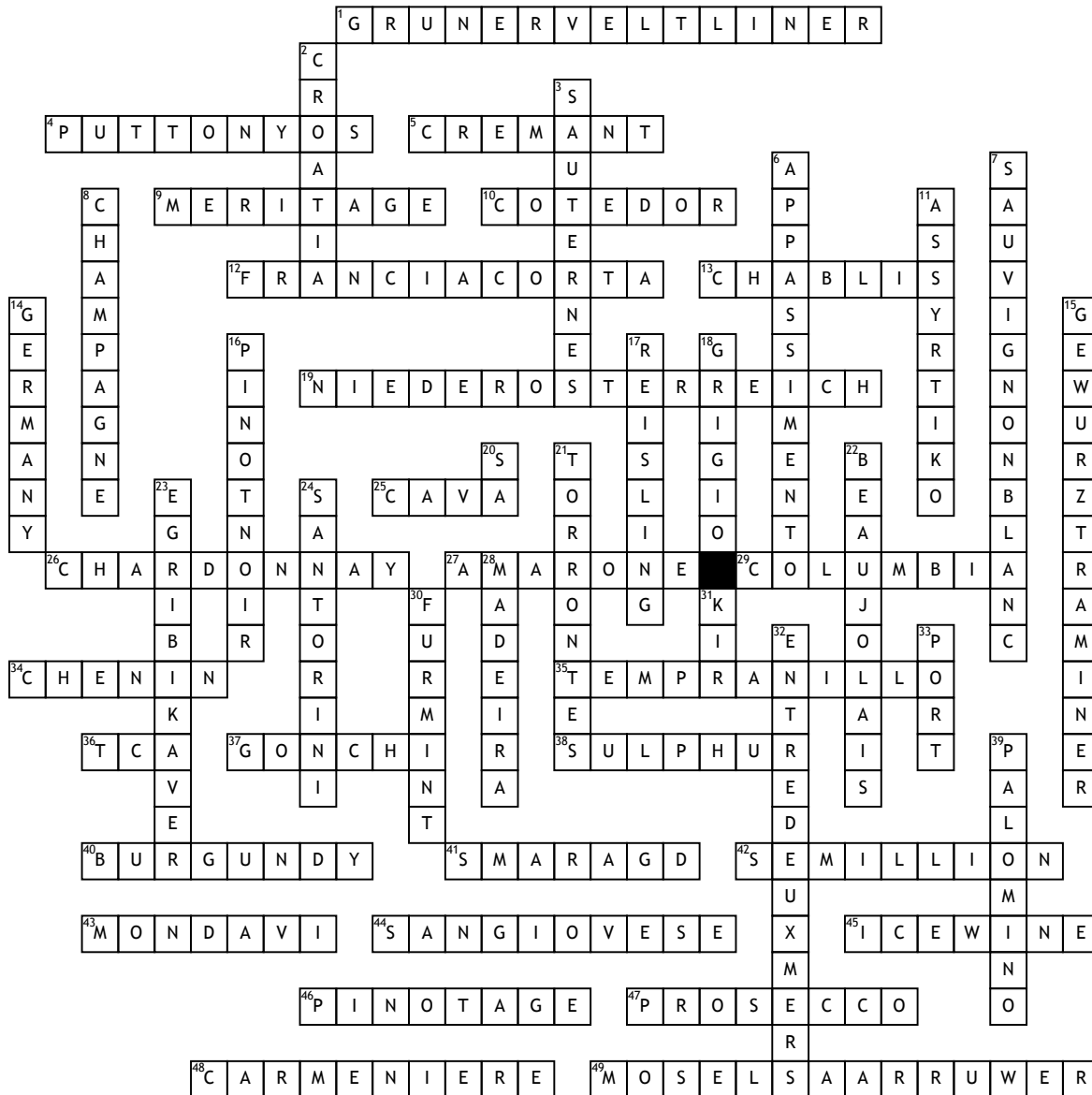


Wine Terminology
