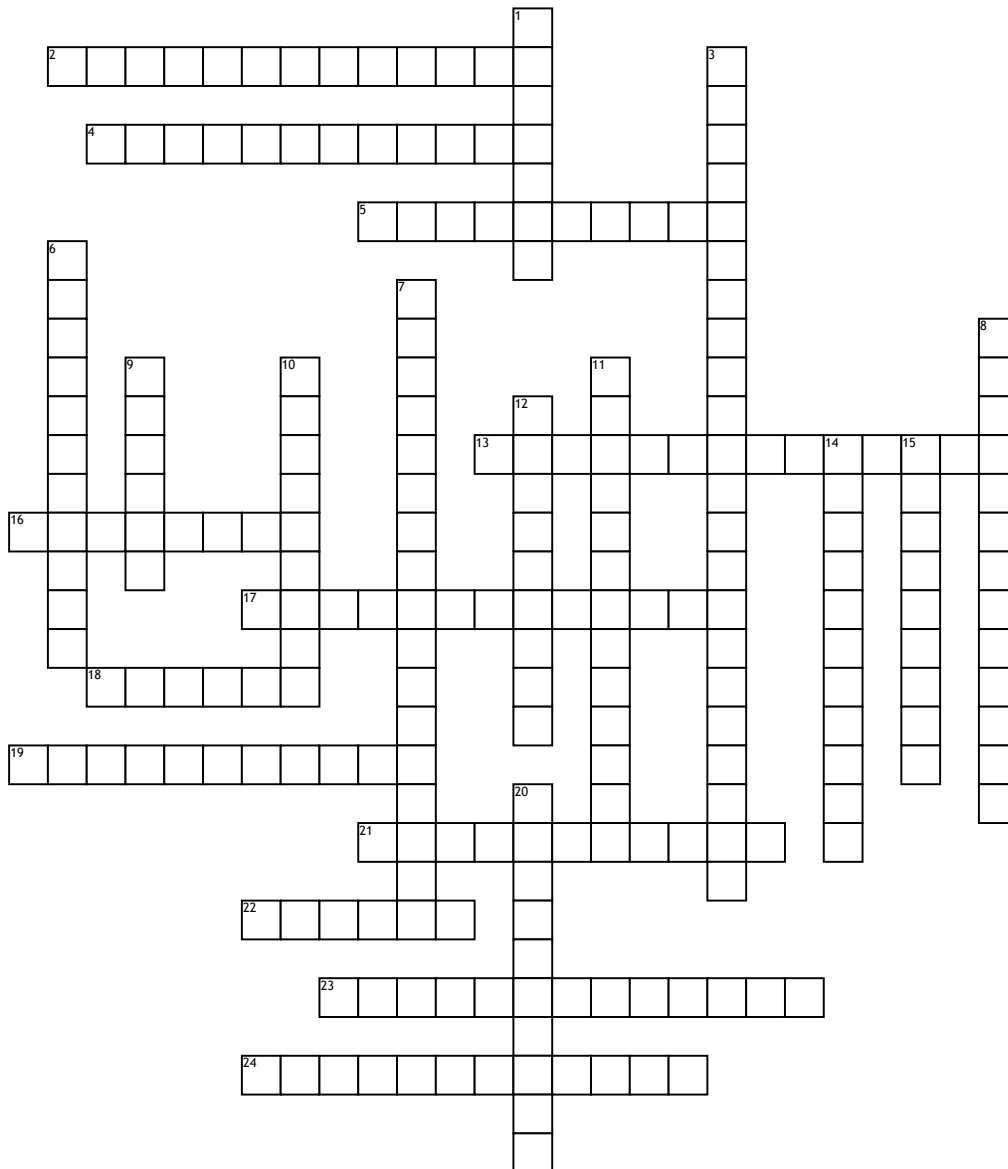


World War 1

- 2. war from inside trenches enemies would try killing each other with machine guns, tanks, and poison gas
- 4. the protection of merchant ships from U-boat-German submarine-attacks by having the ships travel in large groups escorted by warships
- 5. Area between the trenches in World War I, filled with barbed wire
- 13. Part of the Central Powers; had many different nationalities within country all wanting their own nation
- 16. a war measure that prevents anything going into a country or going out of the country, including goods and weapons.
- 17. Message proposing an alliance between Germany and Mexico; one of the reasons the US joins the war
- 18. German submarines; a new weapon of the war; convoys were used to stop them

- 19. Part of the Allies; suffered the most casualties; pulled out
- 21. These weapons fire a very fast stream of bullets for a long time (500-600 bullets/min)
- 22. Alliance consisted of Great Britain, France, and Russia
- 23. Alliance consisted of Germany, Austria-Hungary, and the Ottoman Empire
- 24. Part of the Allies; largest navy in the world; blockaded the Germans

- 1. Part of the Central Powers; spent most on army & navy than any other European country; declared war on Russia first; received total blame for the war
- 3. Austria-Hungarian heir assassinated by a Serbian nationalist; the spark of WWI
- 6. expanding your power outside of one's own borders; one of the MAIN causes of WWI
- 7. warfare reliant on the use of gas or diesel engines, tanks, airplanes

- 8. process where Hungarians will be in control of parts of the Hungarian government
- 9. Part of the Allies; Battle of the Somme and Battle of the Marne took place in this country
- 10. dirigible bombers that could level buildings in seconds
- 11. Part of the Central Powers; The "old man" of Europe
- 12. British passenger boat with 128 Americans on board sunk by German U-Boats. It also secretly had ammunition in the hold; one of the reasons the US joins the war
- 14. uberpatriotism AND desire by common people to have own homeland; one of the MAIN causes of WWI
- 15. mutual defensive treaty; one of the MAIN causes of WWI
- 20. Depending on one's military to determine foreign policy; needs constant escalation of armed forces; one of the MAIN causes of WWI
