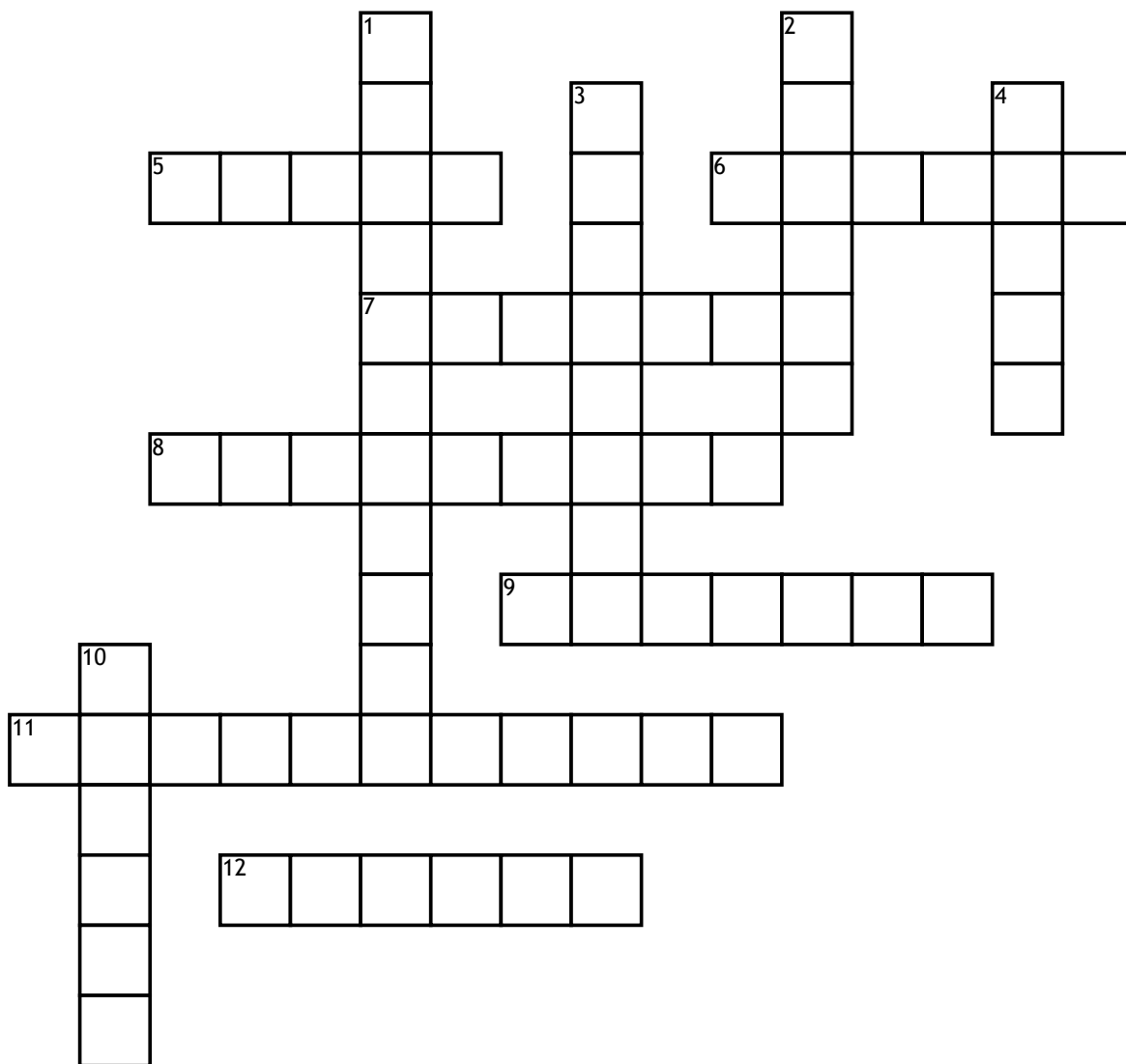


# World War Two Crossword by Cody Rayner
