

- 1. Erosion of tissue from underneath intact skin at the wound edge
- **4.** Tubes that provides a means for removing blood and drainage from a wound
- 8. Damaged skin or soft tissue resulting from trauma10. Separation of wound edges
- 11. A period during which new cells fill and seal a wound

- **12.** Dead tissue on a wound surface that is moist, stringy, yellow, tan, gray, or green
- **13.** A technique for flushing out debris in a wound
- **14.** A combination of new blood vessels, fibroblasts, and epithelial
- **15.** A cover over a wound **Down**
- **2.** Dry brown or black devitalized tissue

- **3.** A strip or roll of cloth wrapped around the body part
- **5.** Cell duplication
- **6.** A period during which the wound undergoes changes and maturation
- **7.** A wound caused by prolonged capillary compression
- **9.** wound separation with protrusion of organs
