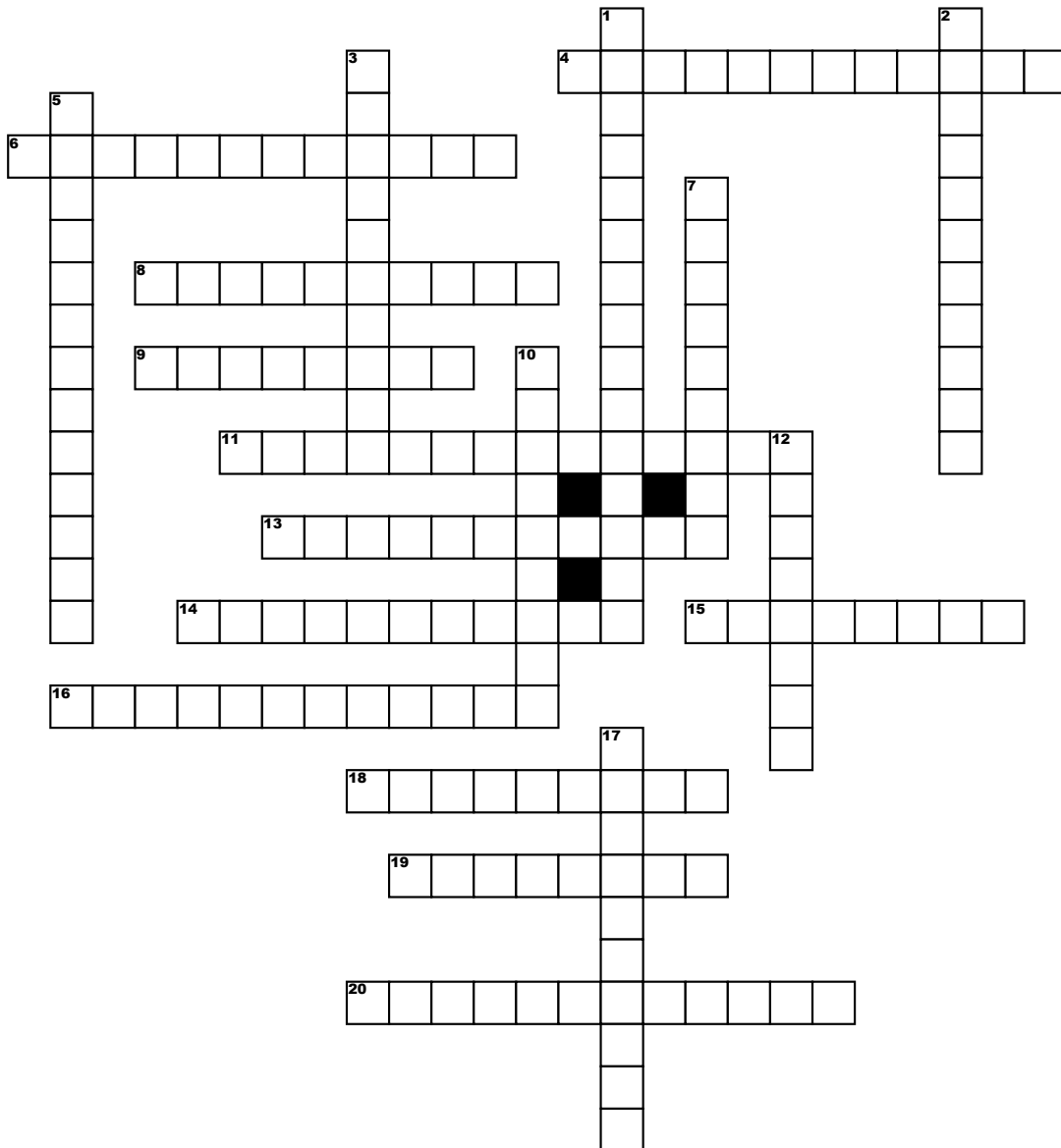


Woven and Knitted fabrics
