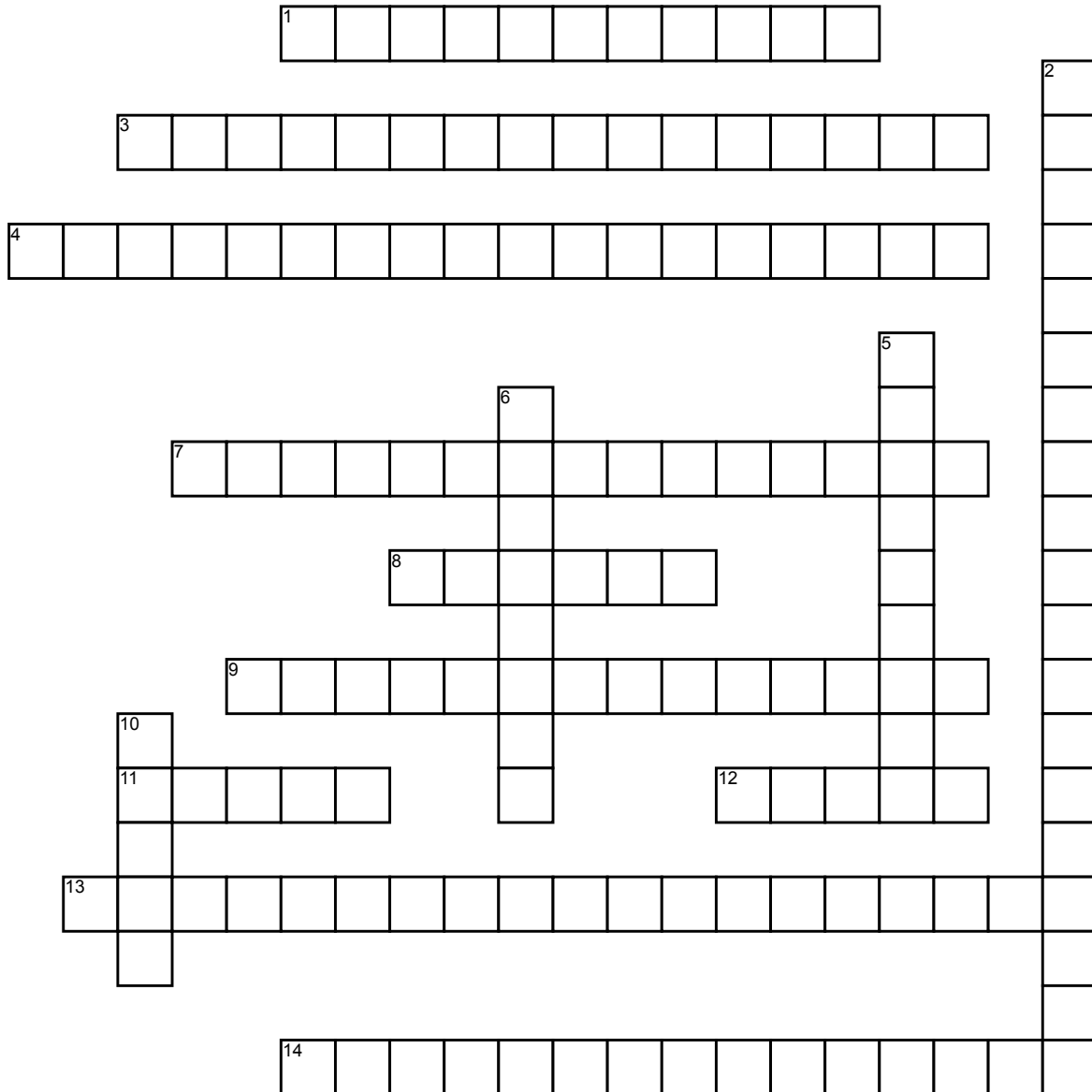


# Yr10 Glossary
