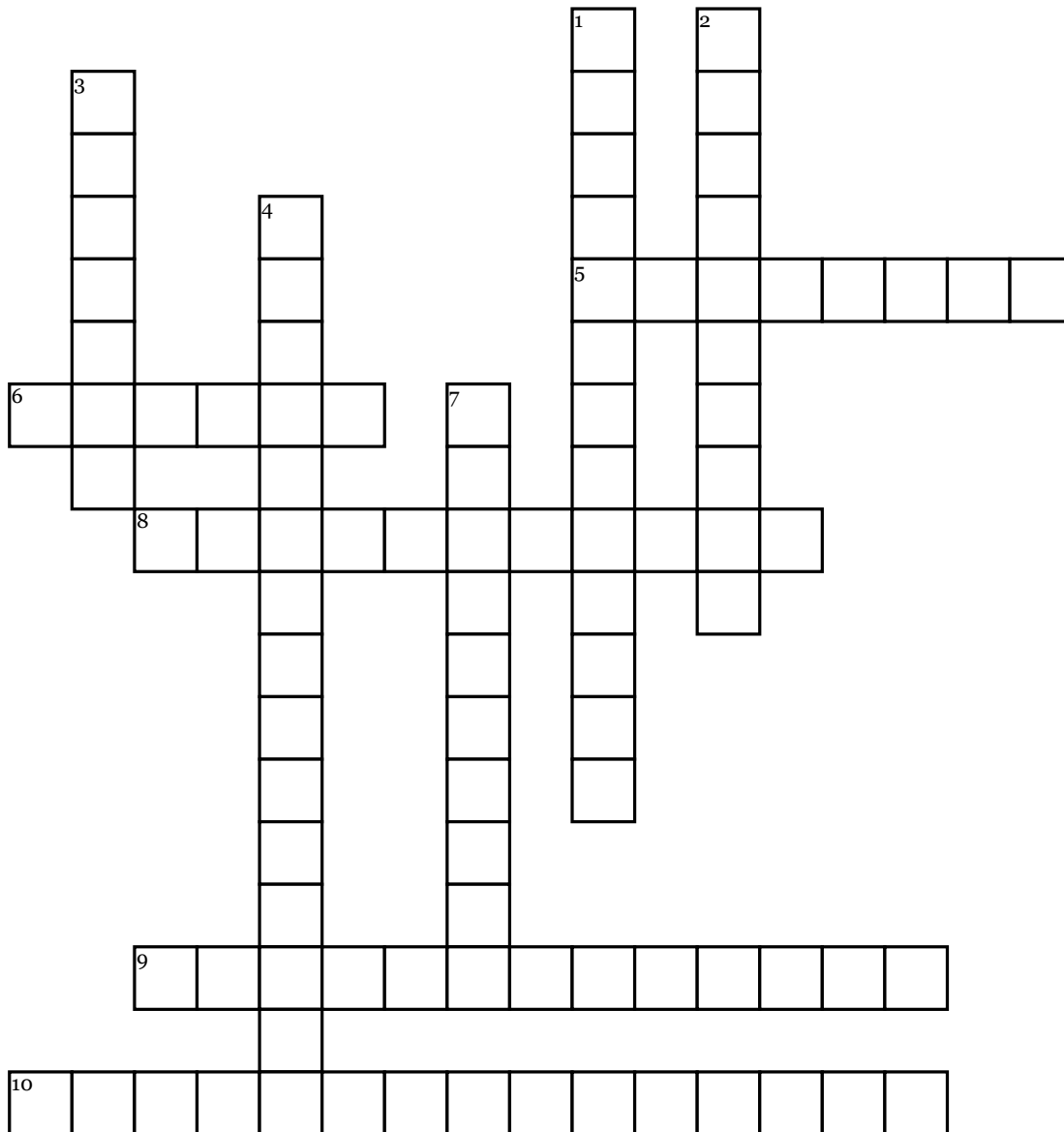

## Across

**5.** Living skin around the nail plate that becomes split or torn.

**6.** Vertical lines running the length of the natural nail plate that are caused by uneven growth of the nails, usually the result of normal aging.

**8.** Also known as spoon nails; inverted or concave nails.

**9.** Tiny pits or severe roughness on the surface of the nail plate

**10.** Dark purplish spots, usually due to physical injury

## Down

**1.** Fungal infection of the natural nail plate.

**2.** Bacterial inflammation of the tissue surrounding the nail.

**3.** Inflammation of the nail matrix followed by shedding of the nail.

**4.** Blue or purple nail bed, usually from poor circulation.

**7.** Also known as athlete's foot.
