

- **5.** Living skin around the nail plate that becomes split or torn.
- **6.** Vertical lines running the length of the natural nail plate that are caused by uneven growth of the nails, usually the result of normal aging.
- **8.** Also known as spoon nails; inverted or concave nails.
- **9.** Tiny pigs or severe roughness on the surface of the nail plate

10. Dark purplish spots, usually due to physical injury

- **1.** Fungal infection of the natural nail plate.
- **2.** Bacterial inflammation of the tissue surrounding the nail.
- **3.** Inflammtion of the nail matrix followed by shedding of the nail.
- **4.** Blue or purple nail bed, usually from poor circulation.
