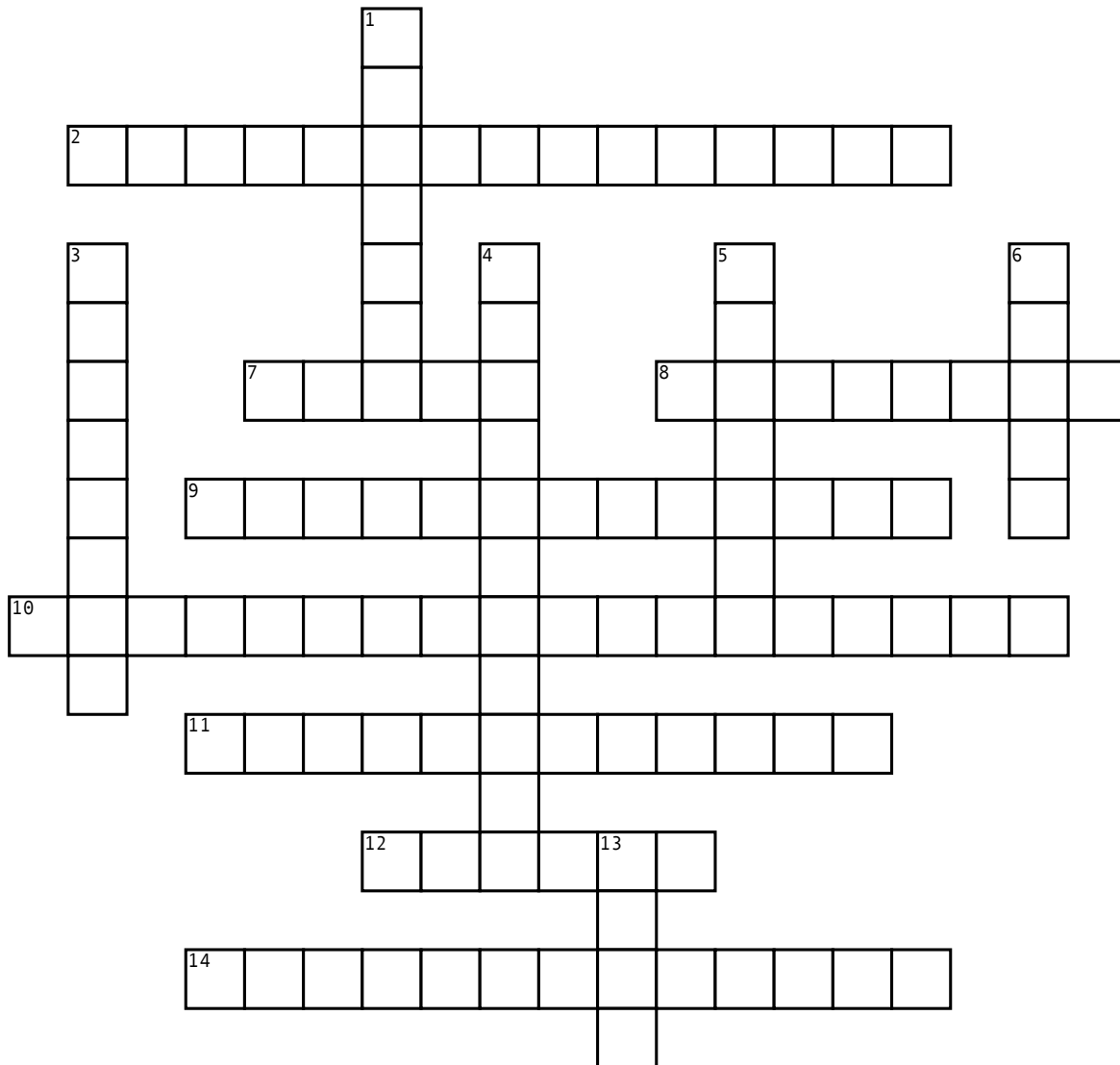


Endocrine and Reproductive systems
