
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Knowing The Sewing Machine Parts

- 2. has measurements to help you sew straight, supports fabric during sewing
- **3.** guide when making buttonholes
- **12.** is actually a tension disc that regulates tension for bobbin winding
- **13.** moves fabric along under pressure foot
- **14.** set tension according to fabric, stitch, and thread-how tight the thread is being pulled

- **15.** leads thread to needle **Down**
- 1. change stitch length and width (creates zig-zags)
- 4. attaches pressure foot to machine-buttons to release foot and can change easily to attach different feet
- **5.** hold the top thread in place
- **6.** holds fabric against feed system/teeth

- **7.** can stitch backwards to lock stitches into place
- **8.** guides thread when winding bobbins
- **9.** raises and lowers pressure foot
- **10.** controls movement of take up lever and needle, turn wheel towards you to stitch slowly
- **11.** controls flow of needle thread-must be threaded properly or machine will not work correctly
