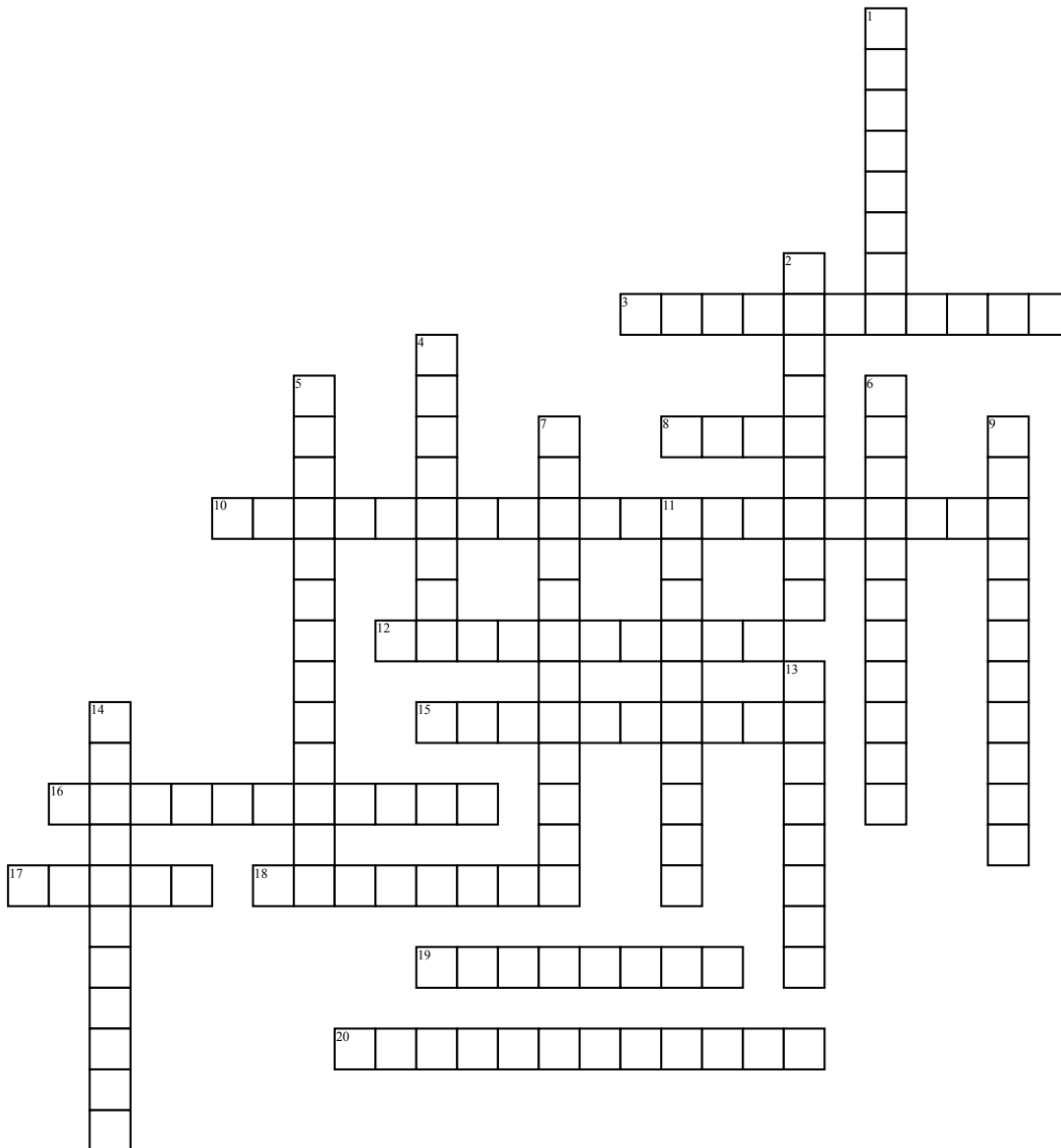


Leo's Vocab Crossword Puzzle

- 12. the state of not supporting or helping either side in a conflict, disagreement, etc

- 16. a policy of extending a country's power and influence through diplomacy or military force

- 17. physical restraints used to hold someone or something prisoner, especially ropes or chain

- 4. a union or association formed for mutual benefit, especially between countries or organizations
- 5. a type of combat in which opposing troops fight from trenches facing each other
- 6. patriotic feeling, principles, or efforts.
- 7. compulsory enlistment for state service, typically into the armed forces
- 9. the reduction or withdrawal of military forces and weapons
- 11. the belief or desire of a government or people that a country should maintain a strong military capability and be prepared to use it aggressively to defend or promote national interests
