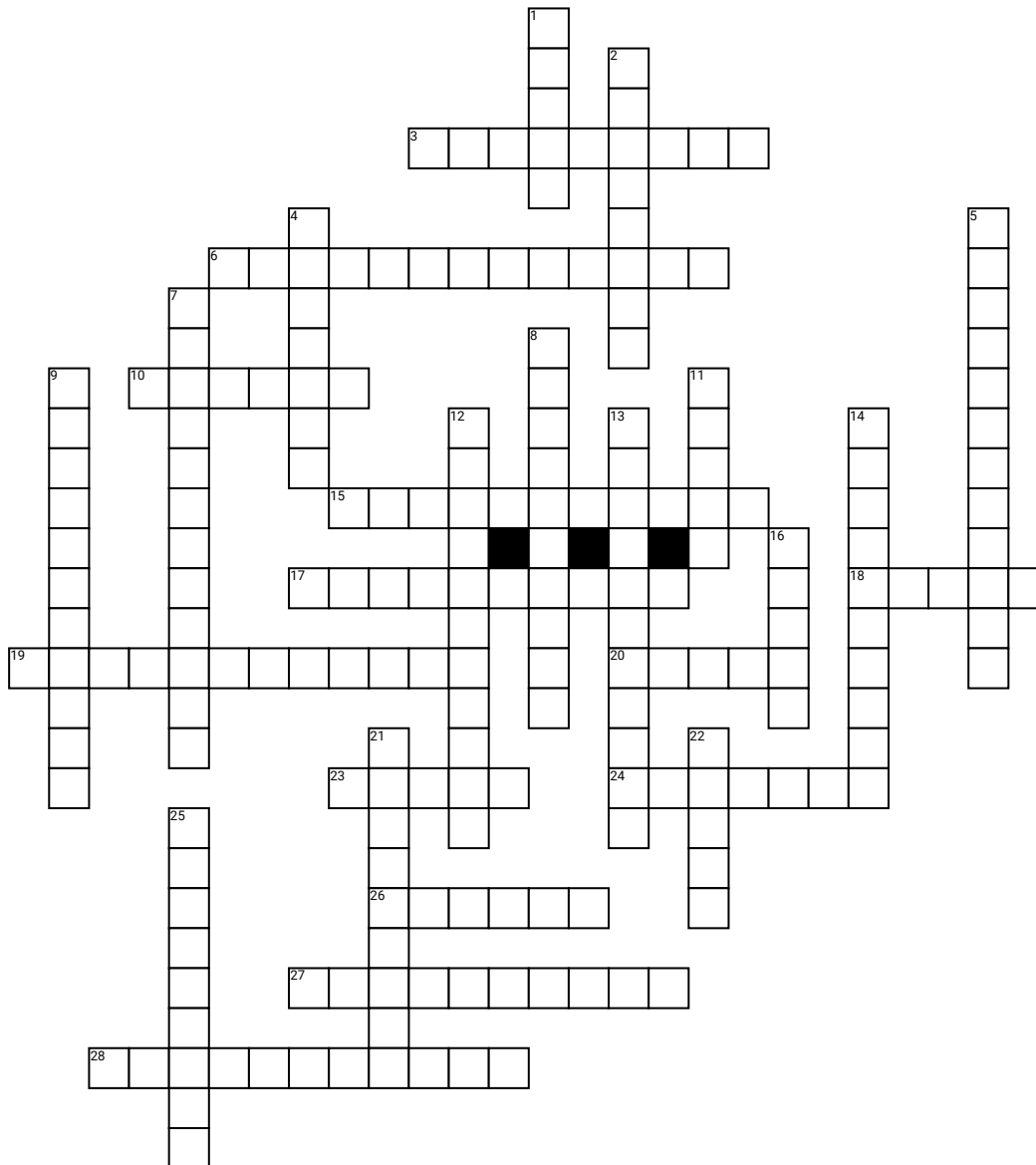

1. The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated
2. the ability of individuals to bring suit against states in federal court
4. the right to a jury trial in certain civil cases
5. prohibits both congress and the states from conditioning the right to vote in federal elections on payment of a poll tax
7. limit a number of times a person is eligible for election
8. prohibits intoxicating liquors
9. repealed the 18th amendment

11. No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury

12. prohibits the states and the federal government from using age as a reason for denying the right to vote to citizens of the U.S. who are at least 18 years old
