


# anatomy crossword



## Across

- 3.** the mucous membrane lining of the uterus  
**4.** the thick uterine musculature  
**10.** Accessory organ of the male reproductive tract that produces a milky fluid that contributes to semen by activating sperm  
**14.** Segment of the male duct system that links the epididymis to the ejaculatory duct  
**15.** the female copulatory organ that runs from the cervix to the outside of the body  
**16.** Portion of the male duct system in which sperm mature  
**17.** the female sex organ in which ova (eggs) are produced

**19.** The canal through which urine passes from the bladder to the outside of the body

**20.** fingerlike projections that line the distal end of each uterine tube

## Down

- 1.** Tubes that carry urine from kidney to bladder  
**2.** A group of blood vessels, nerves, and ducts that are wrapped in a connective tissue sheath that travels through the inguinal canal  
**5.** Glands located at the base of the bladder that contribute to semen by providing a food source for sperm  
**6.** Tiny glands inferior to the prostate that produce clear mucus that neutralizes urine prior to ejaculation

**7.** Fluid mixture produced by male reproductive structures; contains sperm, nutrients, and mucus

**8.** male primary sex organ that produces sperm

**9.** hollow pelvic organ of the female reproductive system that functions to receive, retain, and nourish a fertilized egg

**11.** The second part (from the opening where the fimbriae receive the egg) of the uterine tube

**12.** uterine tube

**13.** the release of an ovum (or oocyte) from the ovary

**18.** the inferior necklike portion of the uterus leading to the vagina
