

- 2. Doctrine that Jesus is truly present in his Body and Blood under the form of bread and wine in the Eucharist.
- 3. unbroken chain of power and authority connecting the pope and bishops to St. Peter and the 12 Apostles
- 5. to bring Good News about Jesus to others
- 7. Divine life-giving actions that originate from God the Father. His blessing is both word and gift.
- 10. the "birthday of the Church" from a Greek word meaning "fiftieth day" celebration of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the Apostles
- 12. priesthood of the faithful Christ has made the Church a "kingdom of priests" who share in his priesthood through the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation

- 13. priesthood of Christ received in Sacrament of Holy Orders its purpose is to serve the common priesthood by building up and guiding the Church in the name of Christ.

 - 15. reflection given by a bishop, priest, or deacon that reflects on the Scripture readings during Mass or the Sacraments helps us hear God's Word and apply it to life

- 1. the Real Presence of Jesus consecrated species of bread from Mass that is reserved in the tabernacle in Church
 - 4. win in the Eucharist. Transubstantiation what happens when the bread and wine are turned into the Body and Blood of Christ

- 6. Divine Office public prayer that makes holy the entire course of the day and night
- 8. from the Hebrew word Shabbat, "to cease" weekly day of rest and worship in Jewish faith 7th day of the week (Saturday) for Jews Sunday for Christians (Lord's Day)
- 9. 3-day liturgy that is the Church's most solemn celebration of the Paschal Mystery. It begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and concludes with the evening prayer on Easter Sunday. Although it takes place over 3 days, it is considered one single liturgy.
- 11. another name for the Holy Spirit that means advocate, defender, or comforter
