

- **17.** The blood vessels that nourish the epidermis are located here

- **2.** Dark pigment that gives skin its color
- **3.** This layer is located below the dermis
- **4.** This condition is caused by over active sebaceous glands
- **6.** These are caused by the contraction of the arrector pili muscle

- **9.** The hypodermis is mainly composed of this connective tissue type
- **10.** This membrane lines cavities and cover organs
- 11. This cell type protects tissues from uv light and gives skin it's color
- **12.** This type of sweat gland responds to a rise in body temp
- 13. The membrane is called skin
