

- 15. This amendment shall not be so construed as to affect the election or term of any Senator chosen before it becomes valid as part of the Constitution
- 17. That the legislature of any State may empower the executive thereof to make temporary appointments until the people fill the vacancies by election as the legislature may direct.
- 18. You cannot prevent a person from voting because of race, color, or creed.

- 1. President takes office on January 20th instead of March 4th.
