

- 3. Proposed by George F. Kennan in February 1946, this policy involved taking measures to prevent the extension of communism
- 4. The US provided aid to 16 European countries to prevent "hunger, poverty, desperation, and chaos."
- 7. Soviet Union version of NATO; comprised of Soviet Union and other satellite nations.
- 8. March 12,1947; the US gave \$400 million to Turkey and Greece. "The US must support free people who are resisting attempted subjugation by armed minorities or by outside pressures."
- 9. House of Un-American Activities Committee; Investigated communist influence in the movie world and the sneaking in of propaganda into films.
