

2. A line in a document that can be set to repeat automatically at the top of each page; usually indicates a title, name or date

4. a box in a graphic user interface that appears when one opens a disk or folder to display its contents

7. input device that a computer user moves around on the table beside the computer in order to control a pointer on a screen, and presses down (click) in order to select options from the screen
8. the main circuit board inside a microcomputer that holds all of the integrated circuits, chips, and connection slots for attaching additional circuit boards required to control peripheral devices (eg. monitor, keyboard, disk drive)
