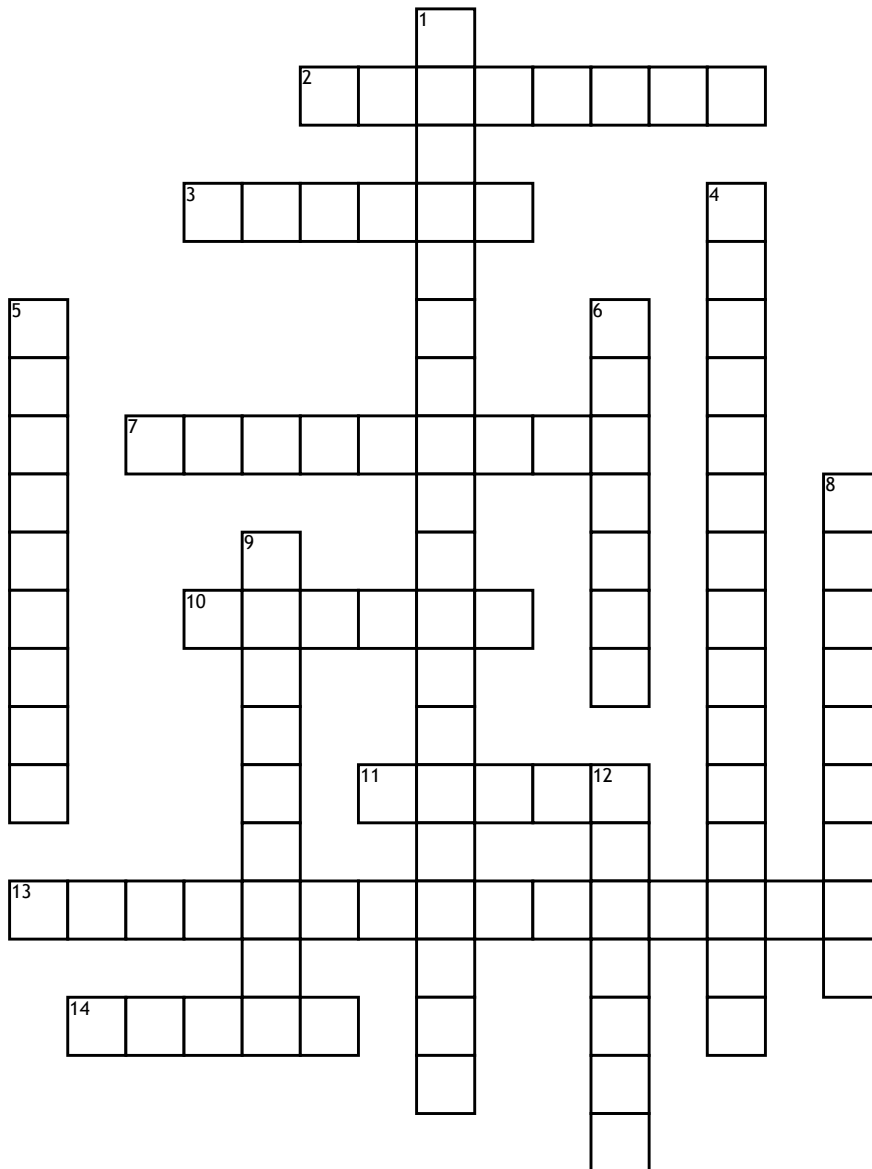


crossword puzzle- Dejah h, Ms.Demsar, ADA101.
