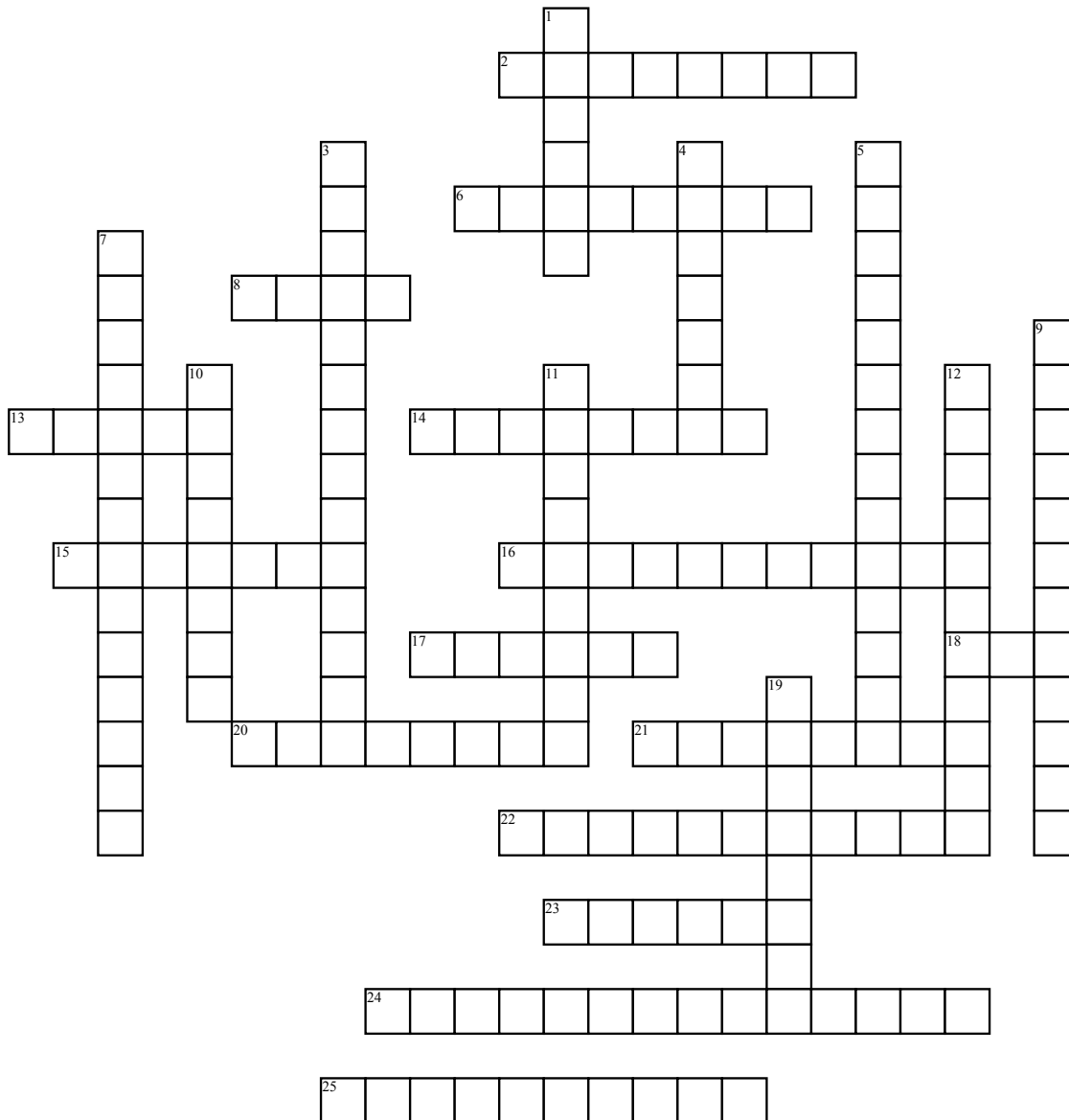


# final project crossword
