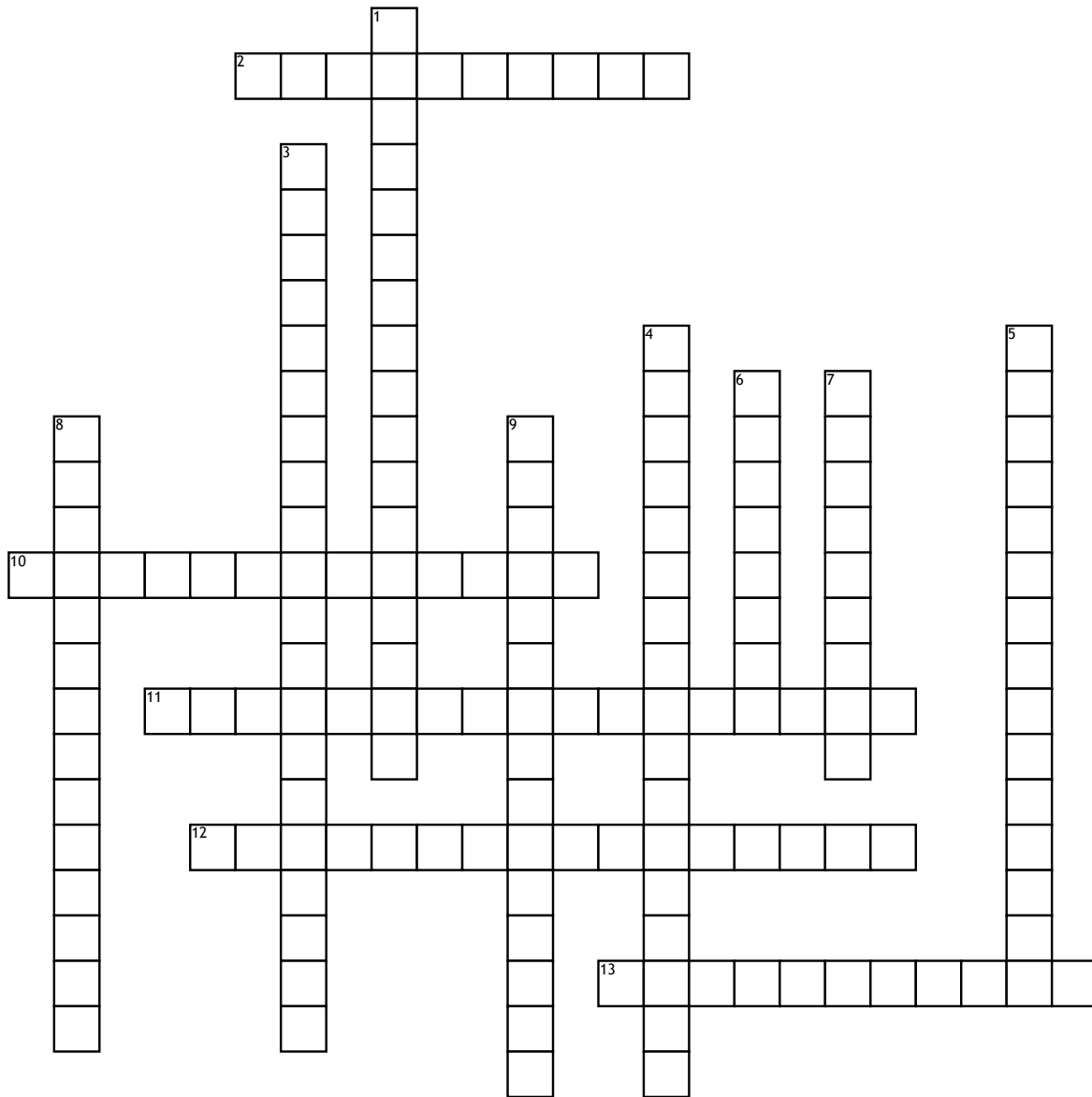

13. the person who serves as the ceremonial head of a country's government and represents that country to the rest of the world, can be a monarch or president

1. a government where political authority rests with a nation's citizens; basic rights of citizens are protected by law

3. having a legislative divided into an upper and a lower house

4. the part of the government that is responsible for the entire country (national level)

5. governments of smaller areas such as regions, states, provinces, or cities

6. a single leader who holds limitless power in an autocratic government; often uses force to silence the opposition

7. government where political authority rests with a single leader

8. the top elected official in charge of enforcing laws and carrying out government policy

9. a form of government in which citizens vote directly and not through representatives
