

 4. A turning stroke performed with the paddle planting at the feet and sweeping back to the back of the kayak  
 7. A paddle stroke used to move your boat sideways  
 9. The stroke that paddlers used to move themselves forward in the water

10. Made with a light frame with a watertight covering having a small opening in the top to sit in  
 11. A shad with two blades on either end that a paddler uses to maneuver the kayak  
 12. Water without any current
