

## **Across**

- **3.** attaches presser foot to machine-button and can change easily to different feet
- **8.** guide when making buttonholes
- **10.** thread, fabric, and stitch must be set at its according tension.
- 13. holds needle in place
- **14.** change stitch length and width

- **15.** holds fabric against teeth
- **16.** guides when winding bobbins

## Down

- **1.** holds the top thread in place
- 2. controls movement of take up lever and needle
- **4.** measurements help you sew straight and support fabric during sewing.
- 5. leads thread to a needle

- **6.** Lowers and raises presser foot
- 7. is a disc that regulates tension for bobbin winding
- **9.** locks stitches into place by stitching backwards
- **11.** moves fabric along under presser foot
- **12.** it controls the flow of the needle thread. Mus be properly threaded or the machine will not work.
